
8. John the Baptist Points to Jesus

The Jewish people got ready. It was time to meet the Messiah.


Questions

Show students where the story is in the Bible. Use the Bible references above the illustration.

Before you read:

Activate Prior Knowledge

- a) What is the yuckiest thing you ever ate? Why did you eat it?
- b) If you lived in the wilderness, what would you eat and wear?
- c) Why do you think John chose to live in the wild?

After you read:

Shining Light

John was a burning light. He shined the way to Jesus. Collect a <u>variety of light forms</u>: a candle (be careful if you light it around children), an electric candle, a flashlight, and a lamp. Get creative: a lightning bug, a glow-in-the-dark stick, even a window. We are all different and can shine the love of Jesus into our schools and homes in many ways. Talk about ways that you can shine for Jesus. Turn out the lights. Pass around <u>an electric candle</u> and ask the kids to say a prayer asking God to make them a light burning bright for Jesus.

Do U U-Turn?


Write on a <u>marker board</u> common goals of this world: popularity, riches, comfort, being right and first in everything. On the opposite side of the room, write Christian goals: following Jesus, obeying God, going to church, telling others about Jesus, not insisting on our own way, etc. Take a journey toward worldly goals, but then take a u-turn (repent) and decide to pursue to God's ways.

Signs to Salvation


Learn to point your friends to Jesus. Make signs like the ones on page 6. Cut them out of <u>manila file folders</u> and <u>tape</u> a <u>pencil</u> behind them to use as a handle. Play a game where kids have to stop, yield, u turn, etc. to cross the room. Now, choose five people to hold each sign. One friend can lead a "lost" person from sign to sign while reading the words on page 6. At the end, say a prayer of salvation. Print, keep, learn, and practice the signs with the Bible verses so you can lead a friend to Christ. You can use the page or draw your own signs as you explain the road to salvation. See the verses on page 7.

Get Ready

John was a sign helping people get ready to meet Jesus. Look in the mirror. Who are YOU? Are you a voice calling the way to God? Are you a sign? Do you point to Jesus? Are you a light? You can be. As you prepare for church, school, sports, family events, clubs, or to play with friends, say the prayer. Cut, color, and post it on your mirror.




Follow the Signs to Jesus




1. ONE WAY

Jesus is not just one way to heaven. He is the only way. (John 14:6)




2. U TURN

God allows U-turns! You must repent of your sins. This means that you turn around your mind and your life to follow Jesus. (Mark 1:15)




3. STOP

Stop ignoring God. Agree that Jesus died for your sins, and rose from the dead. Thank him! (1 Peter 3:18)



4. YIELD

To yield means give up your own way. Ask Jesus to be your Savior and Lord. (Romans 10:9-10)




5. KEEP RIGHT

Now, keep going the right way! Decide to follow Jesus every day for the rest of your life.

(1 John 2:28-29)



VERSES: Follow the Signs to Jesus




1. ONE WAY

2. U TURN


"The time has come," Jesus said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!" Mark 1:15


