

#### Dear Parents,

This summer were using an exciting educational game called Prodigy. Students will play with the same character at home that they setup there account with while in school. They will come home with their username and password. They will start with a placement test so it will seem easy (do not help them or they will be placed incorrectly), then it will level out. They need to complete 80 minutes a week or 20 minutes a day, however they would like to do it.

## Help your child by registering a free parent account after they register at school.

- 1. Go to www.ProdigyGame.com, and select 'Get Your Free Account.'
- 2. Once you're logged in, select 'Link your child's account to see their progress.'
- 3. Select 'Add Students' and then set the toggle to 'Existing accounts.'
- 4. Enter your child's username and password (they will have it).
- 5. Select 'Link student accounts'.

A Prodigy Parent account gives you access to multiple comprehensive reports, daily and weekly usage data and we'll even email you from time to time about your child's progress!

### How does my child play Prodigy at home?

- 1. Go to www.ProdigyGame.com on almost any Internet enabled device.
- 2. Select 'Play Prodigy' in the top-right corner.
- 3. Once the game loads, enter your child's username and password and select 'LOGIN'.
- \*\*\*The teacher will be able to monitor your students' progress and be prepared for your student in the fall.

# Was your child absent when they registered at school or they lost their username/password?

- 1. Go to www.ProdigvGame.com/play/ and select 'New Student'
- 2. Then enter 'Class Code' (see below) then hit right arrow (<u>do not</u> click "Playing at home?" because your student will not get credit for playing)
- 3. Enter your students first and last name
- 4. Then follow prompts. Students should select the grade level they are currently in, not next year's grade!!!!
- 5. Make sure to write down your student's username, password, and keep it somewhere safe.
