Each piece is finely crafted of lead-free pewter with rhodium plating. The necklace is available in three styles as shown above. The sterling silver is a daintier version for those who prefer a more elegant look and feel. The chains are 16" (adjustable to 18" for sterling and 20" for other two styles), and each necklace has our ministry name on the hang tag, so you can always remember the most vulnerable children when you wear yours. 100% of the proceeds directly support the initiatives of Open Hearts for Orphans.
