Dues & Fees Structure

- **Due Date** ALL dues must be received by the Treasurer on or before **April 30, 2019**
- **Mailing Address** Maplewood Swim Club, PO Box 125, Southampton, PA 18966
- **Instructions** Register / list the names of all family members you intend to have a membership in 2019 on your on-line Dues Invoice. We will use this information to prepare your Membership key fobs. Also, please list the ages of each of your children. If your child wishes to have their nickname used, please note this information. Please indicate if your child's last name is different from the Member's last name. Finally, Membership key fobs are issued to children under 3 (age as of May 25, 2019), so please include their names on your on-line dues Invoice.
- **Dues Structure**

\$ 540.00	Family Membership (Two adults living in the SAME "household")
\$ 00.00	Children age 2 and under (age as of Opening Day – May 25, 2019)
\$ 75.00	First five Children living in the household who are between the ages of 3 to 17
\$ 40.00	After the 5 th child - Each child living in the household between the ages of 3 to 17
\$ 75.00	Each "adult" child (18 to 26) of the bondholder living in the "household"
\$ 180.00	Each Senior Citizen member (65 & older)
\$ 280.00	Parent of Member living in the home of the Member
\$ 180.00	Senior Citizen parent of Member living in the home of the Member
\$ 100.00	Baby Sitter (Age 14 & up) – Must accompany child of Member
\$ 435.00	Single Adult Membership*
\$ 60.00	Supplemental Fee for Non-Bonded members (excludes first year memberships)
- We accept credit card payments for annual dues for a small convenience fee
- **Daily Guest Fees**

\$ 8.00	Monday to Fridays (except holidays)
\$ 10.00	Saturday, Sundays & Holidays

50% off standard daily rate when entering the Club after 5:00 PM
No "special" Group or Party Rates & No "Rain Check" Policy
- **Guest Passes**

Members may purchase \$50.00 blocks of guest passes for \$40.00 when submitting their annual membership dues by the due date of April 30, 2019. Guest Passes earned or purchased expire when member turns in their bond or does not pay current annual membership fee.
- **Late Fee Policy**

Members who do not pay their dues by June 16, 2019 or fail to obtain a "Leave of Absence for the 2019 Season" by June 16, 2019 or fail to notify the Corresponding Secretary in writing by June 16, 2019 of their intention to resign from the Club will have a \$25.00 late fee assessed. This late fee must be paid in addition to the regular dues. A resigning member will have any outstanding dues and/or late fees deducted from any amount payable when the Resigning Member's Bond is sold to a new member.

- **Definitions**

"Household" = The Club's dues assessment structure is first based on the number of adults living in the same household who desire to use the swim club. Each household must have at least one adult member who has a paid membership for the current season. Next, the number of children of the adult member living in the household between the ages of 3 to 17 (regardless of the child's desire, ability or intent to use the Club during the 2019 season). A family is not required to pay membership dues for a child who will graduate from high school in June 2019; however, the family may elect to have membership privileges for this child.
