

# Claudia M. Kopack

## 1917 – 1998

Claudia M. Kopack, age 81 of Bay Port, passed away Monday, November 9 at Four Seasons Healthcare Center, Bad Axe.

She was born in Ottawa, Ontario, Canada on May 24, 1917, the daughter of the late Joseph Claude and Elizabeth Betty (Tipper) Kelle. On February 6, 1937 she was united in marriage to Charles M. Kopack in Detroit. He preceded her in death in January, 1977.

She was a graduate of MacKenzie High School in Detroit. When younger, she enjoyed knitting and crocheting. During World War II, she worked at the Willow Run Bomber Plant. Mrs. Kopack also enjoyed cooking. She was a member of St. Roch Catholic Church in Caseville.
