

## STONEGATE FARM Red Pine Hunter-Jumper Horse Show

**JULY 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, and 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024**

RPHSA is excited to host the third show of the 2024 season at Stonegate Farm. Farm address is 11130 Julianne Avenue North, Stillwater, MN 55082.

Here are a few important things to know.

**VACCINATIONS & COGGINS:** All horses visiting the farm must have a negative Coggins within the past 12 months and flu/rhino vaccination within the past 6 months (but not less than 2 wks before show date). You **must** bring a **copy** of both records to the show office before unloading your horse.

**ENTRIES close July 15<sup>th</sup>**, or before, if full. Late entries will be accepted if space allows.

Arrival- please do not arrive before 6:00am each show day.

**\*IMPORTANT\*** If you need a stall, you must email or text Missy 763-350-9237 to reserve. You will **not** have a stall if you reserve one at Horsehowsonline--you must contact Missy. Exhibitors requesting a stall must submit their entry at [www.horshowsonline.com](http://www.horshowsonline.com) within 1 week of reserving stall in order to keep reservation.

Cost of stabling per day is \$65/day (1 bags of shavings is required). Overnight is additional \$20; horses moving into stalls on Friday or Saturday night for overnight stabling should not plan to get stall before 6pm. Limited tack stalls may be available after stabling requests are fulfilled.

### SHOW RINGS & SCHEDULE

Full schedule is available at [HorseShowsOnline.com](http://HorseShowsOnline.com).

Three show arenas: (1) **Main** sand outdoor ring, (2) **Ring #2** (sand outdoor) and (3) large **indoor** ring.

**FRIDAY/SATURDAY HUNTERS:** An identical schedule will run Friday and Saturday for hunters in both arenas. Walk-trot will be held in indoor. Crossrails through 2' will be held in Main Ring with adjacent schooling area. Classes 2'3" and up will be held in RING #2 sand outdoor ring and use indoor ring for warm up.

**SUNDAY JUMPERS:** Crossrail, .65m and .75m will be held in **Main Ring** arena with adjacent schooling area. The 0.85m and up will be in **Ring 2** outdoor ring and use the indoor ring for warm up.

***\*SHOW MGMT RESERVES RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY AND ADJUST SCHEDULE AS NEEDED AND BASED ON ENTRIES\****

Please use designated lunging area---see Farm map.

## **SCHOOLING**

Schooling is available on Thursday afternoon for \$30/horse. Schooling on Friday evening will be determined by when classes end for the day. No riding after 6:30pm any days.

Schooling should be available each morning before show rings open at 6:30am; rings close 30 min before classes begin in each ring. Schooling during show will be available in designated arena---see Farm map.

NO LUNGING IN SHOW OR SCHOOLING ARENAS. Please use designated lunging area---see Farm map.

## **CLASSES**

HTAP- If you are showing an eligible Thoroughbred in 2'3-2'6 hunters (Class 81 or 91) or 0.85m Schooling Jumpers (Class 231), you must sign up for the companion HTAP class in order to be eligible for prize money. Horseshowsonline is Hunters=Class 500FRI or 500SAT and Jumpers=Class 501. More info can be found at <http://www.rphsa.com/htap.html>

Stake classes- Riders must enter one, non-stake class at the same height in order to be eligible for stake class prize money.

1.0M Mini Prix is open to professionals, amateurs and juniors.

## **FEES**

Method of payments include: Credit card (3.5% fee), cash or check.

When you complete your online entries at [horseshowsonline.com](http://horseshowsonline.com), your credit card will hold your reservation but will not be charged until the weekend of the horse show. Cancellation or no-show will incur a \$30 office fee, and stabling charges and schooling fee, if applicable. The credit card on file will be charged unless other arrangements are made with show secretary.

Stall fees- see STABLING section above. Shavings \$10/bag.

Office fee- \$30 per horse; late entry fee is \$40 per horse.

Classes- \$30 per hunter/equitation class; \$40 per jumper class; specialty classes vary and cost will be posted at [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com)

Add Scratch fees: After 8am on day of Show \$5 per change; Day before show is no charge

RPHSA non-member fee \$8 per rider

Fee for a non-showing horse is \$75 per show day if not entered in 2 or more classes each day.

Prize money is forfeited if entry checks out of show office before results are entered in horse show management system.

## **CANCELLATION POLICY:**

**OFFICE FEE:**

- Once a horse has been entered online at [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com), the office fee is non-refundable.

**STABLING:**

- Full refunds will be given until entries close.
- Once entries close, no refunds will be given for any reason. (Vet or otherwise)
- Rider(s) may substitute an alternate horse.

**SHOW SCRATCHES:**

- Full refunds will be given until entries close
- Once entries close and up to 48 hrs before the first day of the show, scratches will be charged the office fee. No exceptions.
  - Reserved stabling/bedding fees will be charged.
- 48 hrs before the first day of the show and through the show, scratches will be charged the office fee and a daily schooling fee. No exceptions.
  - Reserved stabling/bedding fees will be charged.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

Food will be available onsite Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

No camping onsite unless you have permission from Tracy Grandstrand 612-231-6452.

Method of payments include: Credit card (3.5% fee), cash or check. NO VENMO

**GENERAL RULES & SPECIFICATIONS**

RPHSA follows the rules and practices as set forth by the United States Equestrian Federation. It is suggested you have access and familiarity with the USEF rulebook. In the event of a protest or discrepancy, it is recommended that the RPHSA representative(s) at the show make a ruling. This is to be first the secretary, then the show manager.

Horse welfare issues are to be brought immediate to the horse show secretary. Horses entered in show are limited to either 6 hunter/equitation over fences classes per day (ie 2 divisions per day) or 4 jumper classes per day.
