## eBay INSTRUCTIONS

### Authorizing PayPal Giving Fund to manage your donations

You can go to Site Preferences in My eBay to make sure PayPal Giving Fund is authorized to manage your donation account. Here's how:

1. Go to [My eBay](#). You may be asked to sign in.
2. Place your pointer over the [Account](#) tab, and then select Site Preferences.
3. Scroll to Third-party authorizations in the General Preferences section, and then click the Show link.
4. Confirm that PayPal Giving Fund is authorized on your behalf.

Note: To revoke the PayPal Giving Fund authorization, select the Revoke this authorization check box. If you revoke the authorization, you won't be able to make donations through the eBay for Charity program.

### Deciding how eBay for Charity can use your contact information

When you make a donation through eBay for Charity, we share your contact information with the nonprofit. If you'd prefer to keep your contact information private, you can change your eBay Preferences. Here's how:

1. Go to [My eBay](#). You may be asked to sign in.
2. Place your pointer over the [Account](#) tab, and then select Site Preferences.
3. In the Selling Preferences section, scroll to eBay for Charity and then click the Show link.
4. Clear the Yes check box.
5. Click the Apply button.

## KROGER INSTRUCTIONS

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR KROGER COMMUNITY REWARDS SUPPORTERS:

All supporters must have a registered Kroger Plus card account online to be able to link their card to an organization.

- If you do not have a Kroger Plus Card, you can obtain a digital Kroger Plus Card when creating an account online or at any Kroger store.

Link your card at [www.KrogerCommunityRewards.com](http://www.KrogerCommunityRewards.com).

- If you have an existing account, click on "Sign In", otherwise click on "Create an Account".
- If you are a new online customer:
  - You will need to enter your email address, create a password, enter your zip code, click on favorite store, and agree to the terms and conditions.
  - Once you are done entering your information you will get a message asking you to check your e-mail inbox and click on the link within the body of the e-mail that was sent to activate your Kroger account.
- Already have a Kroger.com account?
  - Enter your email address and password and click on "Sign In".
  - Click on Community then on Community Rewards" then click on enroll now, complete personal information, click on save.
  - Enter your organization's number or name and then click on "Search".
  - Select your organization and click on "Save".
  - To verify that you enrolled correctly, you will see your organizations name on the right side of your account settings page.
  - Once you are linked, you can start earning rewards immediately toward the organization you are supporting. (Note: The message saying that you are supporting an organization through the Kroger Community Rewards program will start printing on your receipt about 10 business days after you linked your card.)

### View your Rewards Details

- Sign in to your Kroger account
- Go to [www.KrogerCommunityRewards.com](http://www.KrogerCommunityRewards.com)
- Click on "View Your Rewards Details"
- See how much you have earned for your organization! (Note: This information will only be available and updated at the end of each cycle.)

Remember, you must swipe your registered Kroger Plus Card or use your Alt ID when shopping for each eligible purchase to count.

You must link your card every year, starting August 1<sup>st</sup>, to support the organization of your choice.
