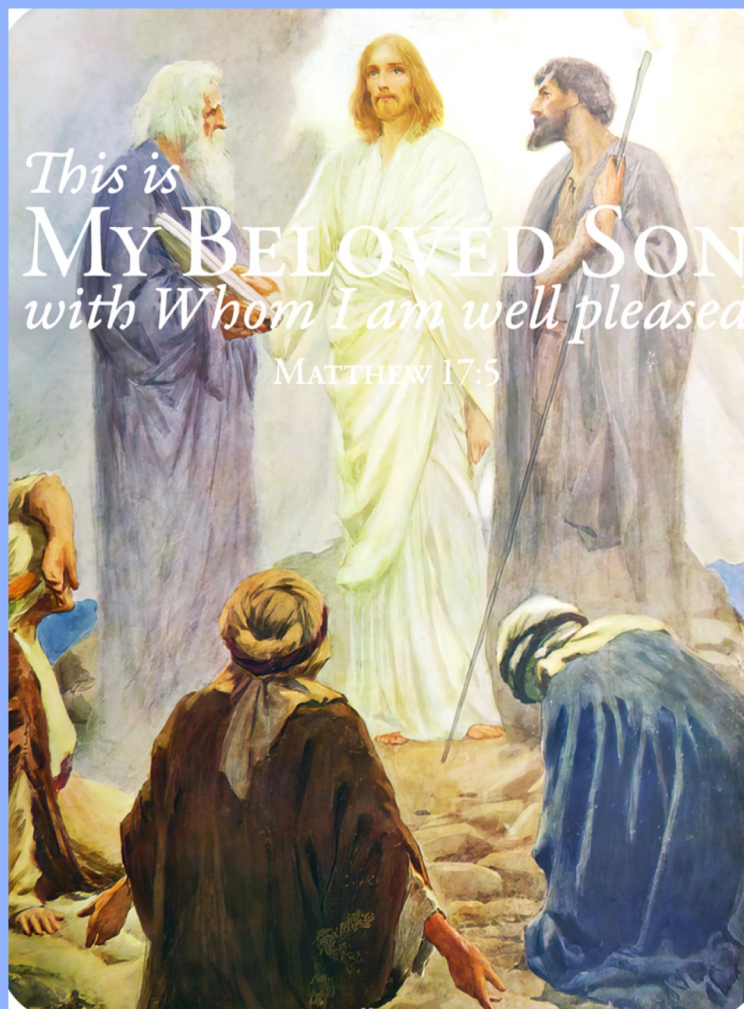

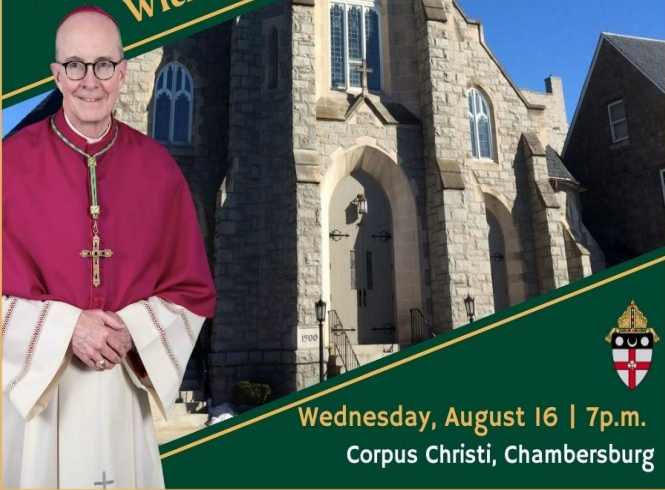

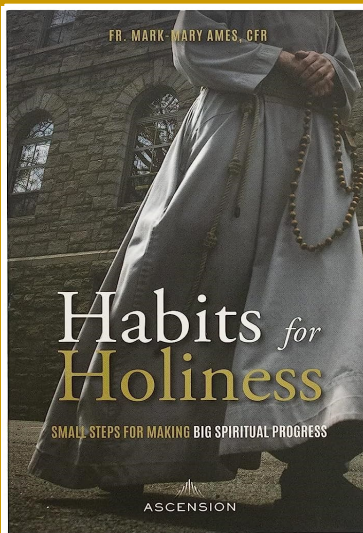

BOOK OF THE MONTH



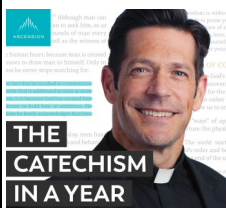
July & August

The new Book of the Month for July & August will be **Habits for Holiness: Small Steps for Making Big**

Spiritual Progress by Fr. Mark-Mary Ames, CFR. This short book, approx. 130 pages, is a powerhouse of good, practical spiritual insights (inspired by St. Francis and Franciscan Spirituality in a real way) written by a young Capuchin Franciscan priest who currently does a number of popular media outreach initiatives online in our modern world [YouTube and Podcasting to name a few]. You will take many golden nuggets away from this book if you give it a chance, and I want to invite you to come to the Book Discussion on **Wednesday, September 6th from 7:30 - 8:30 pm** in the Social Hall. Here are some of the main topics discussed in this book as mentioned on the website: To live within a family and *create a Catholic culture in the family*; To make prayer the center of your life; *Contentment is needed for deep joy*; *Closely listening to others pulls you into the mystery of Christ*; *Recreation can foster growth*; To turn the drudgery of work into the "altar of the desk"; And so much more!

THE CATECHISM IN A YEAR!

Join Father Ben and a big group of parishioners at Our Lady of the Visitation as we learn and grow in understanding about our Catholic Faith by listening to a podcast for about 15-20 minutes a day (that equals only about 2-3 pages of the Catechism, which is not much!).

Religious Education News

Religious Education classes for students in grades pre-k through 8th grade will begin on Sunday, September 17th. A reminder that the Diocese of Harrisburg requires a two year sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation. Class time for grades kindergarten through 8th grade is from 9:30 AM to 10:45 AM on most Sunday mornings during the school year.

The preschool class meets on Sundays from 9:30 AM to 10:30 AM in the church basement (across from Mary's Kitchen). The children are taught Catholic prayers, traditions, and Bible stories—along with crafts and activities. (In a fun and nurturing setting!)

The Word of God Alive:

Discussing the Readings w/your children

Today is the Feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord. Transfiguration means "to change". Jesus changed in front of his friends, Peter, James and John. Jesus and his friends went to the top of a very high mountain. It was here they heard God's voice calling Jesus his beloved Son. Jesus' face shone and his friends could see the fullness of his glory.

How do you think Peter, James and John felt?

We know this really happened because Peter, James and John shared the good news of this event. This is called "testimony". This continued for many generations and eventually it was written down so that we could know about it.

Peter, James and John told of another event of good news that had not happened yet. We call this the day of Parousia. The Parousia is the time at the end of time when God will be "all in". God's glory will shine so brightly that there will be no more need for the sun or the moon because the light of God will be enough. Jesus will come again and his power will not be hidden. In the Parousia, we will not have to wonder any longer about what it was like to see Jesus' glory. We will see it with our own eyes. Until then, we can recognize God's presence with the help of the Holy Spirit. We can listen to God's Word in the Bible.

Living our Faith: Think about all the people who have helped you know God. Thank them for showing you the way to God.
