

# Important information for new families and a reminder for returning families

**Arrival and collection times** for the children are as follows: **8.45 – 9.05** for children who attend morning or full-time sessions. The morning session ends at **11.45** 

Children attending the afternoon session should arrive between **12.45** and **1.00**.

Collection time for children who attend afternoon or full-time is between **3.35 and 3.45**.

It is very important that your child is brought and collected on time.

**Regular attendance** is very important for children's progress and children are expected to attend nursery every day unless they are unwell. If your child will not be coming to nursery because of illness or for any other reason you must call the nursery and tell us the reason for absence.

In exceptional circumstances, which mean you need to take your child out of nursery you must get a form from the office to request authorisation from Annette.

**Entrance to the nursery** is through the yellow gates nearest to Moss Hall Grove. Children must not be brought in through the car park. The car park is for staff, official visitors and for those with disabilities.

Please help us to keep all the children safe by **always** closing the gate behind you, even if you can see the next family arriving; children would be able to get out very quickly if the gate is left open.

Children have **healthy snacks** during the morning and afternoon sessions. We ask parents to contribute vegetables, fruit, oatcakes, rice cakes, breadsticks etc to share.
