

Regular Board Meeting of the Cohocton Town Board



Date & Time: April 21, 2020 at 7 pm.

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Hall at 6:58 pm.

Pledge to the flag led by Supervisor Hall.

Two Letters from Chad Zigenfus read aloud by Supervisor Hall, regarding Local Law No. 4 of 2019; windmill regulations.

Motion made by Supervisor Hall, seconded by Councilman Deussenbery to accept the minutes of the March 17, 2020 meeting. Ayes 4, Noes 0. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion made by Councilman Deussenbery, seconded by Councilman Kastberg to acknowledge reports received from the Supervisor, Town Clerk, Dog Control Officers, Code Enforcement, Highway, and Annual Water Report. Ayes 4, Noes 0. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion made by Councilman Deussenbery, seconded by Supervisor Hall to accept the regular Abstract 004 as presented, with the exception of deleting Voucher number 198 in the amount of \$69,000.00 for the Cohocton Fire Service, as it was paid last month per Supervisor Hall. Voucher total should be just \$96.00. Ayes 4, Noes 0. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion made by Councilman LeVesque, seconded by Councilman Deussenbery to not renew our contract with Pitney Bowes when current contract is up. Ayes 4, Noes 0. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion made by Councilman Deussenbery, seconded by Councilman LeVesque to close pool and park program to do study for the needs of pool for summer of 2020. Ayes 4, Noes 0. All in favor, motion carried.

All Town Credit Cards have been canceled. Supervisor Hall to talk with Five Star Bank about opening new credit cards.

Guest speaker from Abundant Solar was present to discuss new solar farm on Moore Rd.

Motion made by Supervisor Hall, seconded by Councilman Kastberg to introduce Local Law No. 1 of 2020 as "*Repealing Local Law No. 4 of 2019 and providing that the maximum height of commercial wind turbines in the Town of Cohocton shall be five hundred feet*". Ayes 3, Noes 0, Abstain 1 (Deussenbery). Motion carried.

Motion made by Supervisor Hall, seconded by Councilman LeVesque with the intention of declaring the Cohocton Town Board as lead agency and to notify all involved agencies of the Town's intention. Ayes 3, Noes 0, Abstain 1 (Deusenbery).

Motion made by Councilman Deusenbery, seconded by Councilman Kastberg to adjourn meeting. Ayes 4, Noes 0. All in favor, motion carried.
