Reemployment Services & Eligibility Assessments (RESEA):

Impact in Nevada & Other States



Nevada RESEA – Randomized Controlled Trial (2009-2011) Found Sizable Impacts:

- 18% (\$2,988) increase in <u>earnings/claimant</u> over ~2y
- 4% point increase in <u>employment</u> rate at 1.5y (52% treatment vs 48% control)
- \$999 (9%) decrease in total <u>UI benefits/claimant</u> over ~2y (program cost was \$234/claimant)



Nevada RESEA – Replication Trial (2014-2020) Found Sizable Impacts:

- 13% (\$13,324) increase in total <u>earnings/claimant</u> over 5y
 - The yearly earnings impacts were \$2,800 in years 1-4, and \$2,000 in year 5.
- \$457 (9%) decrease in <u>UI benefits/claimant</u> over 1y (program cost was \$290/claimant)




Randomized Trial of RESEA in IN, NY, WA, WI (2015-2017) Found Much Smaller Impacts:

- 2% (\$465) increase in <u>earnings/claimant</u> in year 1, fading to ~0% in year 2
- 1.4% point increase in <u>employment</u> rate in year 1, fading to 0.4% point in year 2
- \$347 (8%) decrease in <u>UI benefits/claimant</u> over ~1y
- Impacts were small in each of the 4 states analyzed separately
