What will be covered??...

This clinic is on Horsemanship Fundamentals --- a deep look into helping your horse understand what you're asking from him so that he can cooperate willingly.

Carson will cover some vital groundwork. This will include creating life in your horse, front end control, hind end control, speed control, rein management, foot placement, stops, balanced turns, shoulder control, and many other topics that focus on small adjustments that all come together to make big changes. You will learn to look for and feel these small changes that many horse owners miss or dismiss as unimportant, but they are what make all the difference.

A major emphasis of the clinic is to become better horsemen ourselves which in turn will make better horses. A Fundamentals clinic provides a good foundation for less experienced riders/horses and helps to refine these essential elements for more experienced riders/horses.

Participants should have control of their horse on the ground, and be able to walk, trot, and lope under saddle on a loose rein. Though specific problems can be addressed, this is not a colt starting or problem-solving clinic.
