Rancho Senior Center **Fitness Center Re-Naming**



Long time Villas resident Mieko "Miki" Harrel passed away in 2017, leaving a donation to Irvine Senior Services, with a request that the funds be used to provide outreach services to seniors and for the purchase of new fitness equipment at the Rancho Senior Center. Miki was an active participant at the Rancho Senior Center, participating in the Fitness Center and Bridge programs and was a Senior Services volunteer, providing hundreds of hours to Irvine's senior community. Her priority was to meet the needs of homebound, vulnerable seniors. In April of this year, the Irvine City Council approved naming of the fitness center at Rancho Senior Center the "Harrel Fitness Center".

The Villas has experienced several incidents of cars being "stored" on the property. Please take a moment to review the Resident's Guide detailing parking. In an effort to keep monthly association dues down, to date we have not hired a patrol service to monitor parking or initiate towing, as it is very costly. Please be a courteous neighbor and follow the rules. Your neighbors will thank you!

Below is a segment from the Resident's Guide:

Overnight parking of a vehicle anywhere on the streets in excess of three (3) consecutive nights is prohibited. Parking in the alleys and driveways, except in designated parking spaces, is prohibited at all times.

No vehicle may be stored on the streets or in the Villas common area parking spaces. Storage is defined as the non-movement or uninterrupted use of a vehicle for a period in excess of seventy-two (72) hours.


