

Wm. 'Bill' E. Mason 11-9-1943 ~ 6-6-2011

William E. Mason, aged 68 and a managing partner/owner of the staffing and executive search firm Mason, Israel & Partners, died suddenly on Monday, June 6, 2011. Mr. Mason, a resident of Irvine, CA, was born in Hutchinson, KS on November 9, 1943.

Upon graduation from Marquette University, Mr. Mason accepted a position with Dunn & Bradstreet. He then served as an officer with The Bank of Chicago before becoming a partner and executive vice president with John Kurosky & Associates. He then served as a partner with Battaglia Winston International prior to becoming a

founding partner of Mason, Israel & Partners.

Following seven years as a Partner with Battalia Winston, Bill re-joined John Kurosky & Associates to direct the firm's activities in retained

search.

During his career, Bill managed multiple successful engagements at the CEO/COO and second-tier management levels in technology, manufacturing, distribution and financial and professional services.

A graduate of Marquette University with degrees in both International Economics and Political Science, Bill spent his early career as an executive with two regional commercial banking institutions in the Midwest. His subsequent management experience included CEO positions with a leading foodservice and healthcare equipment manufacturer, the public holding company parent of Colorado's largest distributor of paint and building materials, and a Denver-based consulting/retained search practice.

A resident of Irvine, CA, Bill served on various advisory boards of emerging companies and served on the West Side Advisory Board of the Los Angeles Orthopedic Hospital Foundation.
