1. Cl. 6-4.3, Small. Black glass specialized to Mary Gregory type (white, shades of white) enamel-like painting DF. Orange County Button Club. \$10, 7, 5
2. Cl. 6-6.7, 20, Any size. Black Glass Lacy Buttons. Label Lusters, other DFs and OMEs (if any). Ronnie Wexler. \$20, 15, 10
3. Cl. 7-4.14 + 7-6.3.2, Small. 20 Radiants and 20 Kaleidoscopes, plus 2 free choice. Label Radiants as to design number, using May 2013 Bulletin article. Carolyn Boes \$10, 7, 3
4. Cl. 7-6, Small. Mechanical make-up clear and colored glass. Wild About Buttons, \$10-6-4
5. Cl. 7-7.7 + 7-7.9, 20 Any Size. Specialized to 10 Lacy Glass buttons and 10 Victorian buttons. Try for a variety of colored bodies. Label pictorials, OMEs, DFs and anything else of interest. **Judging Chair Award.** \$25, 15, 10
6. Cl. 8-3 +23-12, 25 Any Size. Drums specialized to any material mounted in metal. See Blue Book, page 76 for definition. L.A. Button Club, \$10, 8, 7
7. Cl. 8-2 + 17-2.3, 20 Any Size. 19 Peacocks Plus 1 Peacock Eye set in metal (blue/green color only). Peacocks more important than materials. In memory of Dorothy Tunison. Long Beach Button Club, \$10, 7, 3
8. Cl. 17.1 thru 20-24, 20 Any Size. Specialized to Egyptian. No balance necessary among pictorial classes. **Johnny & Louie Memorial Award** (Long Beach Button Club), \$25, 15, 10
9. Cl. 21-5, Small. Pictorials Summary (Secs. 17-20). Specialized to metal. No OME. Label and mount in class order. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15, 10, 5
10. Cl. 24.2 + 24.5 + 24.9, 20 Any size, 6 of each type + 2 free choice among the classes listed. Ronnie Wexler \$20, 15, 10

11. Cl. 1-6 + 2-4, Medium. United States & Foreign Military, specialized to numbered units/regiments; 10 each of the following: United States, Great Britain, Other Foreign. Label usage **Bryce Memorial Award** \$10, 7, 3
12. Cl. 2-4.1. 30 Medium. British Military (Armed Forces). Label usage. Bruce Noland Cole \$10, 7, 3

13. Cl. 2-4, 20 Any size. Specialized to 15 studio buttons made by Stella Rzanski and/or Shirley Shaw plus 5 free choice made by either artist. Buttons should typically be signed by either artist. In memory of Stella Rzanski, and in honor of Susan Porter and Marion Nebiker. Katie Rzanski Cooper, \$15, 10, 5
14. Cl. 7-4.4, 25 Any size. Design in glass surface. Wild About Buttons, \$10, 6, 4
15. Cl. 7-5.4.1, 25 Any size. Painted backs specialized to one-piece construction. No studio buttons. No modern Czech (post 1980). May have front surface painting. Orange County Button Club. \$10, 7, 5

16. Cl. 8-5.1 Medium-Large. Rhinestones/pastes, assorted colors. Modesto Button Club, in honor of Shirley Vikjord. \$10, 8, 6
17. Cl. 12-1.1 + 12-1.3, 25 Any Size. Amino Resin and Phenolic Resin specialized to verified Colt buttons. Label button names and/or numbers. Look for colors, back types, back marks, DF and OME. Sacramento Button Club, \$15-10-5
18. Cl. 12-1.2, Medium-Large. Casein. Try for a variety of colors, DFs, OMEs and construction. Labeling helpful but not required. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15-10-5
19. Cl. 12-1.2 + 12-1.3, Medium & Large. 10 Casein, 10 Bakelite, and 4 free choice. Labeling pictorials, patterns, OME, DF, back mark, and anything else of interest required. L.A. Button Club, \$10, 8, 7
20. Cl. 14-0, 25 Any Size. Wood. Long Beach Button Club, \$10-7-3
21. Cl. 23-6-7, 25 Any size. Snap-together buttons specialized to 10 plants, 10 animals, and 5 free choice among snap-togethers. Look for different colors. San Diego Button Club \$25, 15, 10.

25. Cl. 2-3, 20 Any Size. Satsuma specialized to Pictorials. Try for balance between four Pictorial Sections (Objects will probably have fewer examples than the other Pictorial Sections). Long Beach Button Club, \$10, 7, 3
26. Cl. 6-4, 30 Medium. Black glass with DF. 2 points for each unique DF. **Jane Ford Adams Memorial Award.** San Diego Button Club, \$50, 35, 15
27. Cl. 7-2 +7-3, Diminutives. Clear and colored glass. Labeling not required but appreciated. Wild About Buttons, \$10-6-4
28. Cl. 7-3, 25 Any size. Specialized to uranium glass that glows lime green under ultraviolet light. Modesto Button Club \$10, 7, 3
29. Cl. 8-5.1, 20 Any size. Rhinestones/paste. Must include **one** 18<sup>th</sup> Century paste/rhinestone button. Label type of setting. **CSBS Awards Chair Award** \$15, 10, 5
30. Cl. 11-0, 25 any size. Shell assorted. Limited to entrants who have competed 5 years or less. Trarie Kottkamp \$10, 7, 3

31. Cl. 13-0, Various. Vegetable Ivory assorted. Renée Comeau \$15, 10, 5
32. Cl. 14.4 + 14.7, 25 Any size. Wood with DF and/or OME. Wild About Buttons \$10-6-4
33. Cl. 16-1, 25 Any size. Materials Summary. (Secs. 1 thru 15, except 3) Best assortment. See 2023? Blue Book page 53. Renée Comeau. \$15, 10, 5
34. Cl. 17-0, 25 Any size. Animals that you might look for on a button hunting expedition **CSBS President Award** \$25, 15, 10.
35. Cl. 17-0, 25 Any size. Animals specialized to those you would see on an African Safari. San Diego Button Club. \$25, 10, 5.
36. Cl. 17-1 thru 20-24, 25 Any size. Pictorials specialized to Damascene inlay/overlay. 2 points for each different animal included. San Diego Button Club \$25, 15, 10
37. Cl. 17-1 thru 20-24, 25 Any size. Specialized to pictorials found on an African Safari. Label picture, materials, OME, DF, Backmarks, and anything else of interest. No balance needed among pictorial sections. ABC Button Club, \$25, 15, 10
38. Cl. 20-18, 25 Any size. People with animals. Each button must have at least 1 person *and* 1 animal. Maximum of two studios. **Treasurer's Award** \$15, 10, 5.
39. Cl. 17-2, 25 Any size, Limited. Birds assorted. Look for a variety of birds, materials, activities, etc. Labeling recommended but not required. Limited to those who have not won a Blue Ribbon in Birds. Modesto Button Club, \$10, 8, 6.
40. Cl. 17-2.1, 25 Any size. Domestic Fowl specialized to turkeys, roosters, hens, and/or chicks. Bird activity not considered. Label back marks, materials, OME, and DF. ABC Button Club, \$25, 15, 10
41. Cl. 17-3. 25 Any size. Fish, specialized to Koi. Allowances (BOD) given for artistic interpretation. Beth Robin, \$10, 7, 3
42. Cl. 17-4.4. 25 Any size. Mollusks specialized to Octopuses. Beth Robin, \$10, 7, 3
43. Cl. 17-5 + 18-9 + 20-15, 25 Any size. Specialized to 5 buttons of each of the following: buttons with mammals only, playing an instrument (see page 21 of the Blue Book for a list of mammals); buttons with musical instruments (no people), and, musicians playing an instrument. 10 free choice among the above. No limit on studio buttons. San Diego Button Club, \$25, 15, 10
44. Cl. 17-5.5, Various, Elephants. Sacramento Button Club, \$15, 10, 5
45. Cl. 17-6, 25 Any Size. Reptiles. L.A. Button Club, \$10, 8, 7
46. Cl. 18-1 + 20-22.1.1 25 Any size. Anchors and ships/boats, 10 anchors, 10 ships/boats, 5 free choice of anchors and/or ships/boats. Limited of 2 studios. Marion Nebiker, \$15, 10, 5
47. Cl. 18-6.2 + 20-18, 25 Any size. 20 Fans and 5 People with fans. No more than 15 materials counted for material credit. Wild About Buttons, \$10-6-4

48. Cl. 18-8, 25 Any size. Masks Assorted. (See pg. 54 of the Blue Book) Inland Empire Button Club. \$15, 10, 5
49. Cl. 18-12 + 20-1, 20 Any Size. Specialized to garden decor & garden architectural objects, other than plants. i.e., arbor, garden gate, fountain, bird bath (bird can be in bath). Plants, animals, or people allowed but GARDEN DECOR & GARDEN ARCHITECTURAL OBJECTS should be the MAIN FEATURE. Sonoma County Button Club, \$25, 15, 10
50. Cl. 18-12, 20 Any size. Unlisted objects specialized to sewing related items; people may be present. Limit of 10 realistics. Wild About Buttons, \$10, 6, 4
51. Cl. 19-2, 25 Any size. Flowers assorted. Limited to those who have competed 5 years or less. No more than 5 studio buttons. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15, 10, 5
52. Cl. 19-2.2, 25 Any Size. Irises. Limit of 3 studio buttons. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15, 10, 5
53. Cl. 20-1, 25 Any size. Specialized to Windmills. Label name or type of windmill if known, but labeling is not required. Look for different materials, finishes, techniques, etc. Carolyn Boes \$10, 7, 3
54. Cl. 20-3, 25 Any Size. Astronomical. Sacramento Button Club, \$15, 10, 5
55. Cl. 20-17, 20 Any size. Pastimes, games, sports. People in action. Renée Comeau \$15, 10, 5
56. Cl. 20-21, 20 Any size. Specialized to buttons depicting the Circus. Include as many types and different aspects of circus-related buttons, including animals, buildings, tents, etc. Orange County Button Club, \$10, 7, 5
57. Cl. 22-2.1, 25 Any size. Verbal buttons each of which must include a pictorial. Specialized to Metals. No studio buttons. No OMEs. May include up to 5 buttons from Div. II. 58. Cl. 22-2.1, 25/Any size. Letter/Word (Verbal) Assorted. Inland Empire Button Club. \$15, 10, 5
59. Cl. 23-2.4, Various. Paris or other French backmarks. Label each button with only the *exact wording* (no symbols) of the back mark. Mount on acetate or with elastic thread as described in the BB on page 8. **CSBS Editor's Award** \$15, 10, 5
60. Cl. 23-10, Various. Shapes assorted, *excluding* linear buttons that are round, including balls. Specialized to black glass. Look for best representation of shapes subsets, including realistics. Katrinka Quirk \$15, 10, 5
61. Cl. 25-5. 20 Any size, Livery assorted, specialized to animals, people, and objects seen on a safari. Multiple crests, coat of arms, badges, etc. Can have other subjects as long as one element can be seen while on a safari. Double Ds, \$10, 7, 3
62. Cl. 25-5.2.2, Medium. Pictorial crests assorted. In memory of Tom Barrans. Roberta Schuler \$15, 10, 5
63. Cl. 25-6.1.2 25 Any size. Wobble shank overall buttons specialized to town and/or state names. Abbreviations OK. Include pictorials. Bruce Noland Cole, \$15, 10, 5
