We would like to let our residents know that your February 2025 Utility Bill will be reflecting the new electric rates the Moran City Council approved on October 7, 2024. The rate increase will be allowing the City of Moran to construct their own Substation.

By Moran building their own Substation it will eventually help off set the costs of line distribution which is seemingly going up each year. It will also help in the event of another Storm Uri where we all had to pay astronomical prices. Below are the current charges and the new rates.

## DISCONNECT & RECONNECT CHARGES

If a utility bill has not been paid on or before the 25th of each month, as provided by Moran City Code, a penalty for non-payment shall be assessed as stated on the utility bill. The amount due, plus penalty shall be due by the 30th of each month, except for February when the amount shall be due by the last day of the month, unless the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, in which event the customer has until the close of the next business day in which to pay the charges due.

## Dog Tags On Sale

2025 Dog tags will be available for purchase beginning January 2nd. Tags for spayed or neutered pets are \$2.00 each, all others are \$4.00 each. To register your pet and purchase tags you must provide proof of current rabies vaccination. All dogs 6 months of age or older residing within the city limits are required to be tagged with the city. Kennel licenses may be purchased at \$10.00 each and are required for pet owner registering 3 or more dogs. The City will hold our annual dog tag/vaccination clinic again in March, details to be out in March 2025!

## Code Corner:

### Residential Sewer Rates

The City of Moran uses a winter water based sewer rate to establish your annual sewer rate. Your sewer rate is established based on the average amount of water used at your property during the winter months (December 1<sup>st</sup> through February 28<sup>th</sup>). The average use is calculated and applied to your utility bill beginning on March 10, 2025. Your monthly sewer bill will remain set until March of the following year. The amount of your current water usage does not affect your current sewer bill. To help reduce your sewer rates, limit water usage during monitoring months.

The winter water usage billing method is designed to more fairly distribute the costs of operating the sewer system. Studies show that the water consumed during the wettest months of the year (December through February) approximates average sewer flows. This is because outdoor water use should be at a minimum and most water consumed is returned to the sewer.
