Chinese American Citizens Alliance of Greater New York urges Department of Justice to investigate the practice of de-facto quotas at Harvard and other selective universities

We at the Chinese American Citizens Alliance of Greater New York urge the Department of Justice to investigate aggressively the practice of de-facto quotas at Harvard and other selective universities.

The quota system, operating under the opaque cover of Affirmative Action holistic admissions, implements an unjust, socially engineered outcome that discriminates against Chinese Americans, denying them equal opportunity and equal protection.

As a result of such discriminatory practices, it has been demonstrated again and again that Asian Americans with substantially higher test scores, better grades, and more competitive extra-curricular activities consistently lose out to other applicants. This happens even when the Asian American is poor and immigrant.

Yes, some Asian American organizations will voice support for Affirmative Action holistic admissions. But they do not represent the fearful Asian American youngsters who skip the "Identify your race" question in college applications; those who actually have to go through the process know the lies and corruption that underlie Affirmative Action holistic admissions.

To paraphrase Milton Friedman, when you favor equality of opportunity over equality of outcome, you will achieve substantially both, but when you favor equality of outcome over equality of opportunity, you will get neither.

Let's return America to equality of opportunity, for the benefit of Americans of *all* races.
