## DRESS CODE

Black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers, black tap shoes. Tan or black jazz shoes. Black shorts, capris or pants for jazz and hip-hop, <u>no pajamas</u>!! Dancers must wear a cover-up such as a coat, pants or a skirt when coming to and from class.

Dance it Again!! Gently used shoes and dancewear are for sale on a table in the lobby. Recycling these items helps everyone! You may bring in your outgrown shoes and dancewear, marked with name and price.

#### HAIR UP!!

Hair <u>must</u> be worn up. We are <u>very</u> strict on this point. You must look like a dancer to feel like a dancer. Please fix your hair <u>before</u> class begins.

DO NOT expect the instructor to fix your child's hair.

#### ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

NO ABSENCES PLEASE. New material is presented at every class. Call if an absence is absolutely unavoidable.

PLEASE BE ON TIME FOR DANCE CLASS!! This means 10 minutes early to allow time for warm up. It's not safe to dash in and immediately begin dancing. Most injuries are due to inadequate warm up. *Preschoolers* should <u>not</u> arrive more than 10 minute early - they get too restless waiting for class to begin.

#### THE FIRST WEEKS ....

In the first few weeks of Fall semester, classes are "in transition." Sometimes students need to try out several classes to find their "best fit" for placement. Everyone will be "tucked in" by end of the month. Thank you for your patience.

#### **RECITAL AND RECITAL REHEARSALS**

This year's recital will be held on June 11, 2016 at Garden City High School. Dates of on-stage blocking rehearsal, dress rehearsal and recital will be announced soon.

#### **RECITAL COSTUMES**

Costume payment is due by October 30, the last day of classes before <u>Halloween</u>. Price is \$60.00 for all sizes. <u>One costume payment required for each class</u> - dancers taking three classes need 3 costumes. A \$25 late fee <u>per costume</u> is charged for costume payments received after Halloween.

#### **DANCEWEAR ORDERS**

Let everyone know where you dance when you carry a personalized dance bag or wear dancewear adorned with the DEBORAH CHASE SCHOOL OF DANCE logo! Order forms are available in the lobby and will be submitted on the last Saturday of each month.

#### **NUTRITION**

# TUITION, FEES AND OTHER COSTS

Tuition for all classes is a set yearly fee divided into 5 equal payments and paid bimonthly (every other month). The Registration Fee and first bi-monthly tuition fee are paid upon enrollment. Tuition rates and Registration Fee are shown below. *Tuition is NOT based on number of classes per month.*

60 minute class \$88 / 2month	Registration Fee \$25 / student
45 minute class \$84 / 2month	Annual, one-time, non-refundable. Due by first class.
30 minute class \$66 / 2month	60 min. private \$50/class ★ Open class \$15/class

Subsequent tuition payments are due on the <u>first class</u> in November, January, March and May. A late fee of \$25 is charged for tuition payments received after the 15th of November, January, March and May. A \$40 bank fee is charged for each check that is returned due to insufficient funds.
