Introduction and Welcome	Corey Smith welcomed attendees.

WHEPP/HERC	 The new NCW HERC Coordinator Robbie Deede was introduced and welcomed. A pre-drill discussion of the coalition surge test (CST) will be held 11/8/17 with the actual drill to be held in the spring WiTRAC training will be held 10/11/17 The HCC/PHEP is facing considerable funding changes. Recent update from DHS is that some of the proposed changes have been discarded but final decisions have yet to be made. Members are welcome to contact their US senators and representatives or the office of the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR) to express their opinions about the changes https://www.usa.gov/elected-officials https://www.phe.gov/about/publicaffairs/Pages/default.aspx DHS is beginning to release the tool kits for facilities (SNF, hospice, clinics, OP surgery centers, etc) that have to follow the new CMS emergency preparedness rule. State Trauma/ STAC	 Caitlin Washburn has been hired as the State Trauma Coordinator The ImageTrend Hospital Hub should be functional for hospitals to retrieve EMS charts of patients transported to them. Each hospital should have access. If a record is not present confirm with the service that the correct destination was listed and that the report has been uploaded to WARDS. If it is still not there contact Chuck Happel at the state EMS office. Michael reviewed a letter that was sent by the US Department of Health and Human Services to NAEMSP clarifying that EMS sharing patient care records with hospitals is not a HIPAA violation. Hospitals are encouraged to share this with EMS agencies if needed. The 2018 NTDB dataset has minor changes only.

	 Registry updates New canned reports are available. Users can modify the reports and then save them to their facility folder. Eric did a review and found that an average of 52 minutes is spent entering a case into the registry. This does not include the time needed to collect the information. Elements will begin to be color coded in October to indicate state vs national elements. Dr. Lerner reviewed the ED LOS >3 hrs cases put into the state survey tool and found that 45% of them did not have trauma team activation. For the NCRTAC it is 63%. The STAC has discontinued state-wide review of these cases. Regions can continue if they chose to. The Registry will have the same data elements as the survey tool later this year. The state PI committee is reviewing and updating the PI guide that was released in 2007. They are expecting to include new PI indicators to replace the original six. STAC and the EMS Advisory Board are reviewing and discussing how EMS transport to undesignated hospitals should be handled.
