## From the Pastor

As we continue to walk through I Timothy, we are constantly confronted with the radical nature of God's call in our lives as his people. As God's people, we are expected to live in ways that are often in



direct opposition to what the world says about relationships and the nature of commitment. A good example is the list of qualifications that Paul gives for elders and deacons in I Timothy 3. When I read them, I am reminded of how hard it is sometimes to measure up to God's standards. What I tried to communicate this past Sunday, though, was that none of us are perfect and that none of us get it right every time. Thank goodness that God is patient with us and forgives us when we mess up.

I also tried to stress that the qualifications are not really just for elders and deacons; they are for all Christians. Again, I know this is a daunting realization, but our goal as Christinas should be to grow and mature and become better Christians. I hope all of us will take some time and reflect on how we can more consistently apply God's principles to our lives. This coming Sunday, we will be looking at I Timothy 3:14-16 and we will be talking about godliness. Godliness is a broad concept, but in the context of I Timothy, Paul is using it to refer to conduct for living. I hope to see you in church.
