2018 Board member nominations

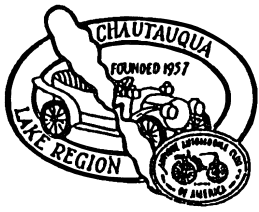

Appreciation Dinner

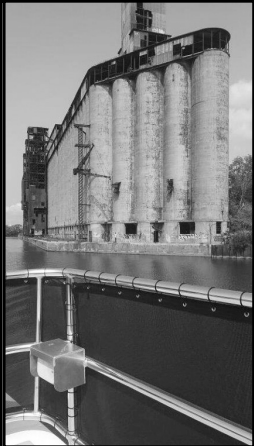

The Club Library



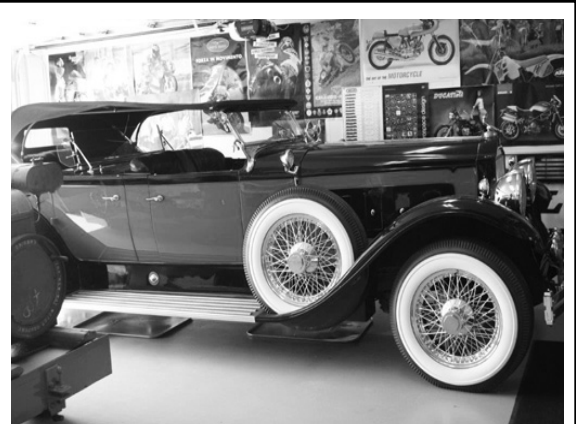

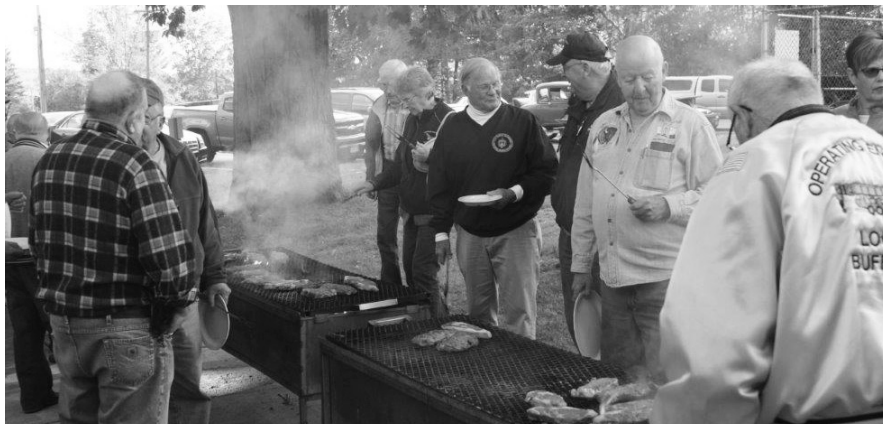
