Amendment to Rules, Regulations and Guidelines for The Point at Walden

The following Amendment to the Rules, Regulations and Guidelines were adopted by the Board of Directors of the Point at Walden Condominium Co-Owners Association in accordance with Article XI, "Rules and Enforcement," Section 11.01, "Authority" of the Bylaws of The Point At Walden Co-Owners Association as recorded in the State of Texas, Montgomery County Registry, and may be added to, amended, or repealed at any time by the Board.

In section XIV, "Enforcement Policy", paragraph B "Fines and Penalties for Rule/Regulation Violations" sentence #5,

"If the violation for which a fine has been levied is resolved, but then later recurs (i.e. repeated) within twelve (12) months of the date of the original infraction, the owner/occupant shall be subject to a new, increased fine in the amount of \$50.00, plus \$10.00 for each additional day that the violation continues."

Ammendment:

The increased fine for a recurring violation will increase from \$50.00 to \$100.00.
