 - 1 conditioning class per week (ballet 5+) *This is not required, but strongly recommended.*
- Attend 2 non-DAL summer intensive auditions (Jan-March) there may be a \$10-30 audition fee per audition
- Participate in Ballet Theatre of Illinois' spring production (May 2023)
- Spring Performance
- Attend a minimum 6 weeks of summer classes Maintain 80% attendance in all classes and rehearsals through the school year and summer sessions

How long is the Conservatory Program?

This is a full school year commitment.

Does Conservatory conflict with Nutcracker or JTI participation?

No, we all work together to make it possible for the dancers to participate in all the programming they are interested in. However, this would not be a good fit if you participate in school sports, cheer, or poms due to time conflicts.

Are all fees due at the beginning of the year?

No, participation fees can be divided between two semesters just as class tuition.
