Unlawful to Install AMI meter here!

MICHIGAN CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT (EXCERPT)

PA Act 331 of 1976 Section 445.903445.903 (1)(hh).

Sec. 3. (1) Unfair, unconscionable, or deceptive methods, acts, or practices in the conduct of trade or commerce are unlawful and are defined as follows:

(j) Representing that a part, replacement, or repair service is needed when it is not.

(Forcing consumer to accept AMI Meter as Replacement)

***This Analog meter is not broken!
It does not need replacement or servicing!***

k) Representing to a party to whom goods or services are supplied that the goods or services are being supplied in response to a request made by or on behalf of the party, when they are not.

(m) Causing a probability of confusion or of misunderstanding with respect to the authority of a salesperson, representative, or agent to negotiate the final terms of a transaction.

(n) Causing a probability of confusion or of misunderstanding as to the legal rights, obligations, or remedies of a party to a transaction.

Michigan Penal Code MCL 750.539d

It is UNLAWFUL to install AMI meter, a data collection device, without "Consent of resident"

NO Permission or contract for AMI Meter has been granted by Resident!

NOTICE -Installation of AMI meter by Utility Agent on this residence without permission is Utility acceptance of legal liability for potential harm to persons, property and future legislation regarding same.

AGENT - Continue Service as originally Contracted.
