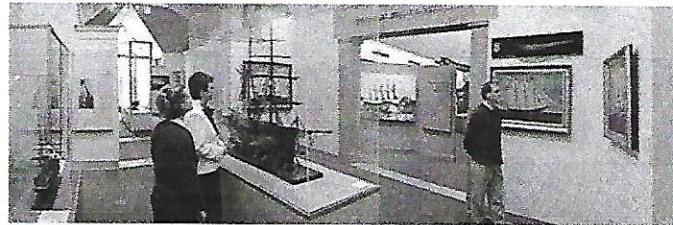


WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2019

After a hot BUFFET BREAKFAST, meet your LOCAL GUIDE for a full day excursion to mid-Coast Maine. Your destination this morning is picturesque BOOTHBAY HARBOR, the boating capital of Maine. Board a large tour boat for a scenic Boothbay Harbor CRUISE (10am-Noon). Sail by beautiful vacation homes, lighthouses, small islands and out to see the seals on the ledges on this fully narrated, two-hour cruise with both open and enclosed decks.

Free time to explore Boothbay Harbor and have lunch on your own. Motorcoach parking is provided in downtown Boothbay. The picturesque village features many casual restaurants along the waterfront, a boardwalk and footbridge to stroll across, unique shops with handcrafted goods and many art galleries. Lots of benches to sit and watch the boats as well. Motorcoach Parking near the Boothbay waterfront is included.

MAINE MARITIME MUSEUM - Located on the banks of the Kennebec River, the museum depicts Maine's shipbuilding industry from the 1600's to the present. Numerous hands on exhibits, boat building demonstrations, a lobstering exhibit, Victorian shipbuilder's home and a special lighthouse exhibit (see the view from the top of the lighthouse without climbing any stairs!).



Free time to explore FREEPORT village, home to the LL Bean sporting goods flagship store and numerous outlet shops.

Then roll up your sleeves and don your lobster hat and bib for a traditional Maine LOBSTER DINNER with all the fixin's!

Tentatively Muddy Rudder, Yarmouth, meal counts 2 days prior:

- Whole Maine Lobster
- Chicken Statler (boneless chicken with drumette attached, served au jus)
- Bistro Steak (flat-iron steak) prepared w roasted garlic demi-glaze
- Pasta with vegetables in pesto sauce

Served with clam chowder, corn on the cob with lobster, chef's choice vegetable with other entrees, potato, blueberry dessert, coffee, tea, soda.

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2019

Head for home after an included BUFFET BREAKFAST.

Options: Stop for a photo at NUBBLE LIGHTHOUSE or oversee the manufacturing of jams and condiments at STONEWALL KITCHEN (both located in York, just before the NH/Maine border). Restrooms at both locations, 1 hour south of Portland.

(Approximate arrival back to Jordan, NY late afternoon after rest, and meal stops)
