\* 2-Man Best Ball - a golf format for teams comprised of two golfers who play their own golf balls throughout and the lower score between them on each hole counts as the team score. Scoring is kept by comparing the holes won by each player. If each has won the same number of holes, the match is said to be "all square". If you have won 4 holes and your opponent has won 3, you are said to be "1-up" while your foe is "1-down."

## NOTE

1. Play Winter Rules: FAIRWAYS - clean & place 1 (one) club-length, no closer to the hole  
ROUGH - clean & place 6 inches, no closer to the hole.  
EXCEPTION - not allowed to touch your ball, if within 1 (one) club-length of a tree
2. Ok to confer with teammate regarding distances off the tee & reading greens
3. **HONORS** is to be observed (the player that is "away" or "out")

\*\* MATCH PLAY - a competition format in which the round is played with the goal of winning individual holes. Scoring is kept by comparing the holes won by each player. If each has won the same number of holes, the match is said to be "all square". If you have won 4 holes and your opponent has won 3, you are said to be "1-up" while your foe is "1-down."

THE MEADOWMORE CUP - a traditional annual 2 day competition between the Meadow Park Men's Club and the Allenmore Men's Club. The event's location alternates between the 2 Golf Course every year. One day's venue is a 2-Man Best Ball and the other day an Individual Match Play game. There are a total of 18 points in the 2-Day event and a majority of the total, 10 or more, are needed to "WIN" and hold the CUP by the winning Men's Club. Each Men's Club selects their own team members
