# "Standards Corner"

### Standard V: Assessment for Student Learning

You will be observed on 5.1 and 5.2 of this standard. The rest will be reflected in your end of year evaluation.

Teachers use multiple measures to assess and document student growth, evaluate instructional effectiveness and modify instruction. This can be done by...

- Designing, adapting, selecting, and using a range of assessment tools and processes to measure and document student learning and growth
- understanding, analyzing, interpreting and using assessment data to monitor student progress and to plan and differentiate instruction

- Communicating information about various components of the assessment system
- Reflecting upon and evaluating the effectiveness of their comprehensive assessment system to adjust assessments and plan instruction accordingly
- Preparing students to understand the format and directions of assessments used and the criteria by which the students will be evaluated

# **Depth of Knowledge**

(DOK) is a model based on the assumption that curricular elements may all be categorized based upon the cognitive demands required to produce an acceptable response. Each grouping of tasks reflects a different level of cognitive expectation, or depth of knowledge, required to complete the task. (Webb, 1997). Please click on the link in the resource section to get a full chart of DOK terms and examples of rigor levels.



## Formative Assessments

- Are NOT graded but are linked to learning experiences
- Assesses student understanding and mastery of skills
- Show students' strengths and weaknesses
- Are used throughout class time for on the spot feedback
- · Are ongoing
- Data is used to modify instruction
- Examples include:
  exit passes
  think-pair-share
  dry erase boards
  quick write
  graphic organizers
  diagnostic pretests
  review games
  classroom observations
  anecdotal records

## Summative Assessments

- Are aligned to content and state standards
- Are graded assessments to mark the end of a unit
- Used to determine if students have mastered specific competencies
- Examples include:
   tests
   unit tests
   quizzes
   state exams
   final exams
   Regents exams
   portfolios
   research papers
   Entrance exams (SAT
   and ACT)
