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Our next meeting will be held **Thursday, November 1st, at 7:00pm** at the **HB Coast Guard Auxiliary**, doors open at 6:45pm.

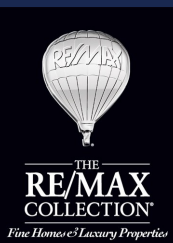

Members who join in November or December are considered paid up as members for the following year.

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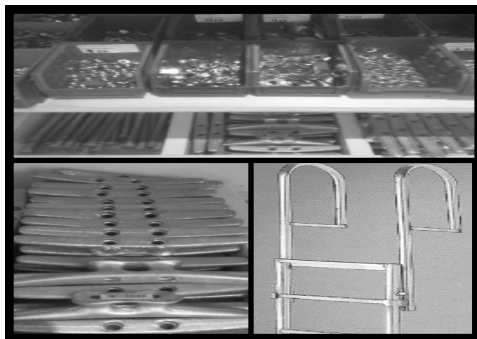


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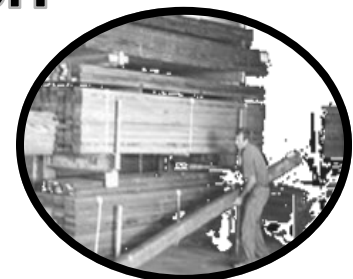


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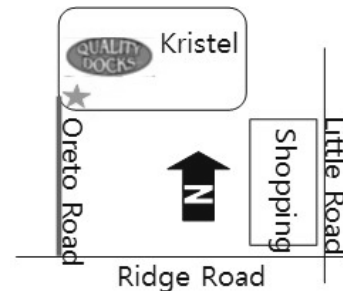

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## MINUTES OF HBPOA COAST GUARD BUILDING October 4, 2018 @ 7:00 PM

The monthly meeting of the Hernando Beach Property Owners' Association was called to order at 7:00 PM by Pat Cordova, Secretary, in the absence of the other three officers, each of whom had recently experienced the death of a close family member or dear friend. Pat led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Homeowners attending the POA for the first time were invited to stand and be welcomed by the membership. All newcomers were encouraged to join our association.

Cecelia Patella, Emergency Management Director of Hernando County, was introduced by Pat. Ms. Patella began her presentation with an update on Hurricane Irma, which hit last year, luckily sparing our area from any major damage thanks to the negative storm surge that occurred. Of course, as we all know, other areas of Her-

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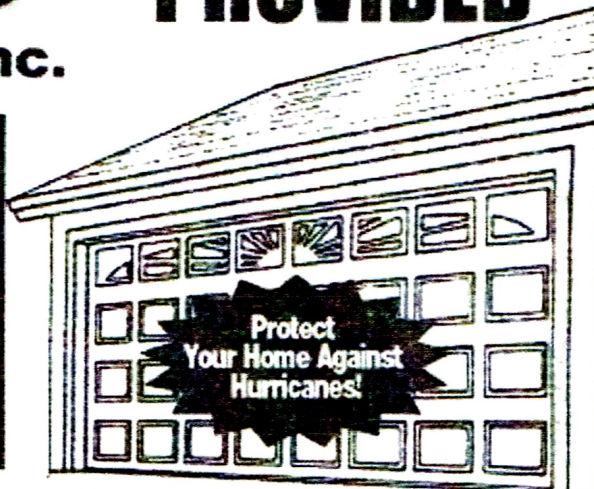
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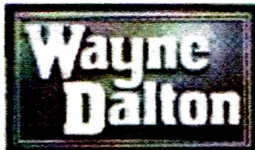
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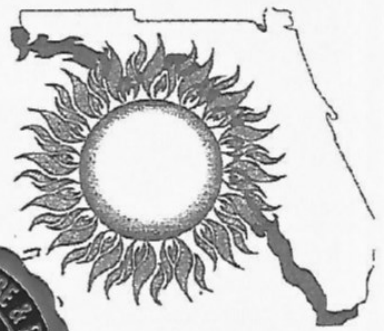

nando County were not as lucky and many people were impacted by the flooding of the Withlacoochee River. Her department is still working with FEMA and trying to get funding to which we are entitled to help in the recovery process. Cecelia applauded the good response to evacuation orders and emphasized the importance of such action when it becomes necessary to issue evacuation orders. She brought Disaster Planning Guides for the Tampa Bay Area for homeowners to take home to assist in planning for any future events.

The second part of Cecelia's presentation was the issue of the Red Tide which actually started in October of 2017 and has been moving toward us, so far reaching as far as Pasco County. Thus far this scourge has not shown up at our coastline but tests are being done at least weekly to keep a close watch. While the Gulf Stream tends to keep such events away from us and moving toward the Panhandle, we certainly cannot become complacent. To that end a lot of preplan-

ning is going on, especially on how to deal with the terrible problem of fish kill that the Red Tide causes. The health impact on humans is respiratory irritation which can be especially challenging to people with pre-existing respiratory issues.

Alert Hernando is a wireless alert system which is available to all residents of Hernando County. Cecelia encouraged all of us to go to the website and register so that appropriate alerts are received. She did suggest that we limit the options we select with regard to the devices on which we receive the notifications. She also pointed out that we can be selective in which alerts we wish to receive but that hurricane and/or tornado warnings are mandatory. She volunteered the services of her department if any resident needs assistance in registering. Lastly she updated us on the progress of the Hazard Mitigation grant requests.

Pat then introduced Erin Daly, Assistant State Attorney, Special Victims' Unit, who volunteered her time and expertise to go over the Amend-

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ments which will be on the ballot in November. To help in this process, she brought as handouts a publication from HC Supervisor of Elections which listed each Amendment with a brief explanation. Erin pointed out that Amendments #1, 2 and 5 are legislative while #3 and 4 are citizen generated. Each of them is singular in its focus. Numbers 6 through 13 came to the ballot via the Constitutional Revision Commission which meets every 20 years, spends a year traveling around the state and getting input to come up with the various amendments. With the exception of #13, these amendments are "weird" and bundled. Two or three different issues which may or may not be related to each other are covered in one amendment. Erin admonished us to study them carefully and be judicious in how we choose to vote on them. It was pointed out that #13 is not about the treatment of Greyhounds who are used in racing but rather it is being put forward by those who seek personal gain. It would ban all dog racing in the state and would put thousands out of work and create a tremendous loss of tax revenue for the state. Erin urged us all to study the amendments and go to the polls with our

choices having been made and to call her in the interim if we need further help.

The business portion of the meeting resumed with Pat's asking for a motion from the floor to accept the September minutes as published in the Beachcomber. Motion made by Betty McGuire and seconded by Joy Martinez carried.

Gladys Moore gave the treasurer's report as follows:

Balance on Hand as of 9/01/18 was \$17,815.74 and as of 9/30/18 after receipts and expenditures was \$17,426.44. The report will be filed for audit.

Carolyn Manno, chairperson for the nominating committee was invited to give her report. Basically after her committee called every member of HBPOA, there were no volunteers or nominations for any of the offices or for either of the two directors' seats that need to be filled. The nominations will be finalized at our November meeting at which time the vote will be called. Members were encouraged to volunteer to serve our com-

munity by running for a position. The members of the nominating committee were thanked for all their efforts.

## REPORTS:

Landscaping Committee...Gladys thanked all the volunteers who have given so much time and energy to maintaining our two areas and reminded us all that she is a volunteer as well. Needless to say, with all the rain this season both areas have been overgrown with weeds which, in spite of the best efforts, cannot be controlled. Gladys lamented that she has recently been inundated with private messages on Nextdoor suggesting that she (Gladys) needs to get out and weed and she has been rightfully incensed by those who would exhibit such nerve. These people according to Gladys are not members of our association. The suggestion was made that such people be encouraged to get out and help maintain the areas by volunteering to weed or cut the grass, etc.

GAC....Gladys made us aware that though Margo has been away most of the summer, she has

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stayed on top of any pressing issues, specifically H1813-Nature Coast and Gulfstar zoning application. She has even flown in to attend important meetings. Margo is accessible by email or phone if anyone has any questions and will soon be home.

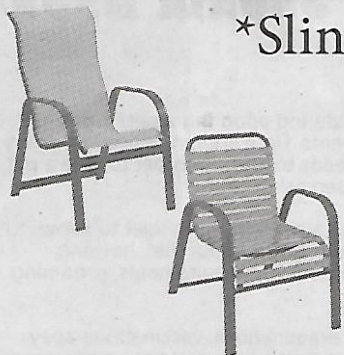
Beachcomber....Pat reminded us on Jen Brown's behalf that the deadline for any submission to the publication remains the tenth of each month.

Port Authority.....Steve Barton reported that a recent decision by the Port Authority to reduce speed at the tight corner on Gulfwind Circle (AKA Suicide Corner) to idle speed has now given a few property owners in that area the idea to apply for permits to have docks. The PA voted to deny these permits; however the owners can reapply to build docks as long as they are 20 feet off the channel.

The second issue was that of the Gulfstar zoning application. By a vote of 4 to one abstention, the recommendation of the PA which will go to the

Planning and Zoning Commission is that there be no increase in traffic at Gulfwind Corner because of safety issues. Steve said that the regular meeting on the third Wednesday will be held at the Coast Guard building. He also encouraged all of us to attend this meeting as well as the Planning and Zoning Commission meeting when this issue is addressed.

Crime Watch...Joe Wach shared that HB Crime Watch is in crisis now, down to three groups who patrol the neighborhood (compared with three open slots for driving a year ago). There are many openings for volunteers to take on this task. The attendance at meetings is down to 4 to 6 people. Recruiting efforts are underway including a tent at the upcoming Cardboard Boat Race and also some changes in how one can apply. Larry Mayer is working on a project to try and raise money for Crime Watch and has asked the community for some PVC pipe to help in this effort. There are several other potential projects and information will

be forthcoming. He reminded us and encouraged us to come out and drive for any length of time. He also reminded us of how important it is for any of us who sees something suspicious to call the sheriff and report it, no matter the time. The sheriff would rather be called even if the suspicion turns out to be unfounded. Joe also pointed out that the sheriff or his representative attends every meeting and reports on any activity in our community. Lastly watch for announcements each month about the monthly luncheon the last Wed or Thurs.

Calendars.....Pat reminded the membership of the beautiful calendar which Gladys has put together for 2019 and has for sale for \$10.

### NEW BUSINESS:

Upcoming special activities....Pat on behalf of Kathy Frase reminded everyone of the Art and Light Festival which will be held in conjunction


### ANNOUNCEMENTS:

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The application, properly completed, is also an agreement to comply with procedures essential to make the program successful. A waiver is included which, when signed, authorizes a Deputy to enter your residence to check on your well-being, should that become necessary.

In the event we do not receive a call from you, a CARE LINE representative will attempt to call you.

If we do not make contact, we will then check with the neighbor/friend you listed on your application.

If this fails, a Deputy will be dispatched to your home to check on your well-being.

Our primary concern is to make certain you have not suffered some injury or illness that prevented a response to our call.

When you enroll with Care Line:

1. You must call the Care Line Office at (352) 797- 3799 every morning between the hours of 6:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.
2. If you are having a medical problem, please state this when you call.
3. If you plan to be away from home for any period of time and will be unavailable that day (or any number of days), you should notify the Care Line prior to your departure and again
