To Queen of All Saints Parishioners

This insert is to share details of the work that is being done by the St. Vincent de Paul Society of St. Augustine's Church in Moncton New Brunswick.

Our charity is located in the basement of the St. Augustine's Villa at 113 Norwood Ave. We run a Clothing Depot and Flea Market from this location. Free Clothing is provided to anyone who tells us they are in need. At the same time, we sell clothing and Flea Market Items to those who choose to shop here. Our shoppers help us to cover our operating costs.

Our prices are very affordable, much less than all other used clothing stores. These items are donated to us through a "Drop off Bin" located in the church parking lot.

Our "Clients" register to receive clothing and can come in every two weeks or as required to choose additional items including things such as bedding and personal care products. At the present time we have more than 1200 families or single registered. This number is increasing daily as many of our new immigrants are now registering for our Free Clothing Program.

The biggest need is men's winter jackets and men's winter boots. There are so few donated that we must take money from our funds to purchase them. We do our best to find warm men's jackets but it is both costly and very challenging. The second biggest cost is Personal Care Products. We purchase everything we need, products such as deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes, soap, razors, shaving cream and shampoo.

We raise money from our daily sales in the Depot and also hold a few Fundraising Sales annually, as our inventory permits. Financial donations from St. Augustine's Parishioners and others, also come our way on a regular basis, especially at Christmas. After our expenses are covered, when possible we also provide financial assistance to our Partners, YMCA Reconnect and Mother Teresa Conference of the St. Vincent Society. These two Charities help people financially to find homes or for families to stay in their homes.

The St. Augustine's St. Vincent de Paul Society is a registered Non Profit Charity formed over 40 years ago to help the needy of our community. All donations are used solely for this purpose. Tax Receipts are provided.

Thank you for your interest in our Mission and for considering us as a charity worthy of your continued support.
