

Caches in the Yorkton Area

N 51° 13.177 W 102° 28.852	Yorkton Button Cache. Just E. S.E. of J.C. beach, a little 15m push into the bush. The cache is a small green soda can holder.	None
N 51° 13.633 W 102° 28.569	This cache is a bit bigger than a shoe box, so bigger trading items welcomed. Big enough to find without hints.	None
N 51° 13.281 W 102° 27.477	A multi-cache located in a back-alley of Yorkton, the final cache is about the size of a shoe box, so larger items welcomed.	1fg—onpx
N 51° 13.169 W 102° 29.122	A 2 stage multi-cache near the Western Development Museum. The 1 st one is a film canister, the second is a green cooler attached to a tree, less than 150m away.	Fgntr gjb – rnfl svaq Fgntr bar – qba'g qebc vg
N 51° 13.064 W 102° 29.397	In the Yorkton Ravine Ecological Preserve, just off a 2.8 km trail (round trip). Small green tobacco container in a stump in the bush. Depending on where you park, you may cross a bridge.	Ybbx haqrearngu gur fghzc. Vg vf ubyybj. Chg pbagnvare onpx nf cynprq
N 51° 11.723 W 102° 23.899	Off the SE back roads of Yorkton. Coming from the west, you'll cross a creek. In a wet spring, come by the east. Cache is a large white plastic container on the ground under some thick poplar trees.	Irel Rnfl Pnpur

How to use the GPS

- Turn it on, go outside and wait until the screen says "ready to navigate".

Calibration

- Press PAGE until the menu appears, scroll to highlight Calibrate and press ENTER. Scroll to hit Compass and press enter. With Start highlighted press ENTER. Make sure that the GPS is level and turn slowly; it will say if you are going too fast or too slowly. This may take several tries.
- Read the cache description you may have to drive a bit before walking in search of the cache.

How to enter cache coordinates

- Hit the PAGE button until the menu appears, go up/down to highlight MARK and press the ENTER button. A picture of someone holding a flag should appear.
- Go down to the coordinates and press ENTER
- Press the up/down buttons to get to the digit/direction you want changed and hit ENTER.
- Scroll down to the number/letter you want and hit ENTER. Repeat as necessary.
- Scroll down to highlight OK and press ENTER to go back to the flagman picture, scroll to hit ok and press ENTER which should lead you back to the menu.
- Go down to Waypoints and press ENTER. Scroll down to the initial of the cache and press ENTER.
- Highlight the cache and press ENTER, go up/down to highlight GOTO and press ENTER.

The compass will point the direction. Hold the GPS level, when the arrow points straight ahead, you're going in the right direction. If the compass jumps around, stand still for a few seconds to let it stabilize.

Check the distance from the cache regularly. When within 10-30 feet pay attention to the clue and the distance.
