



Repentance

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:9-10) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well-being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. (1 Tim. 2:1-2) In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), , and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Lord lift

up His countenance upon you, and give you peace (Num. 6:26). Grace be with you. (1 Tim. 6:21) Glory to God the Father! (Luke 2:14) We don't come to the Father based on our own worthiness or on the worthiness of you and your family, but by Jesus Christ, whose sandal strap we are not worthy to loose. (John 1:27) As God's fellow worker (1 Cor. 3:9), we come before God's mercy seat on the merits of His Son, Jesus Christ, and the precious blood that He shed (1 Pet. 1:19), for worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev 5:12)! In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted (Heb. 2:18), in His name, as a fellow worker in Christ Jesus (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for you and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. It is written, these things that in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray for you and your family: and the word of God is true, pure, proven, living, and powerful: it searches the hearts of man, like a double edged sword, piercing between the spirit and the soul and nothing is hidden from the Mighty One, the Ancient of Days, the holy one of Israel. If we regard the iniquity in your heart, the Lord will not hear. Nevertheless He regards your affliction, when He hears our cry (Ps. 106:44); but certainly God hears us; He attends to the voice of our prayer. Blessed be God, Who has not turned away our prayer, nor His mercy from us! (Ps. 66:18-20)

Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand (Matt. 3:2)! The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. In the name of Jesus, Him on who God the Father has set His seal (John 6:27), let you and your house repent, and believe in the gospel (Mark 1:15). May you and your house take heed, watch and pray; for you do not know when the time is (Mark 13:32-33), but you do know perfectly that the day of the Lord comes as a thief in the night (1 Thess. 5:2). For of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. May you and your people be diligent to put off concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in righteousness and holiness (Eph. 4:22-23). In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the firstborn from the

dead (Col. 1:18), may the God and Father of our Lord **Jesus Christ** bring you and your people by a way you did not know; and lead you in paths you have not known and make darkness light before you, and crooked places straight. These things He will do for you and your house. And you shall be turned back (Is. 42:17), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will repent, turn away from your idols, and turn your faces away from all your abominations (Ezek. 14:6). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and yours will not separate yourselves from God and set up idols in your heart and put before yourself what causes you to stumble into iniquity (Ezek. 14:7). Instead, let you and yours repent and turn from all your transgressions, so that iniquity will not be your ruin (Ezek. 18:30), for unless you repent you will all likewise perish (Luke 13:3). May you all come to your senses, where you have been deceived (Rom. 7:11), and escape the snare of the devil, so that you will not be taken captive by him to do his will (2 Tim. 26). For the Lord is longsuffering toward you and your house, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. (2 Pet. 3:9) In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the God of your salvation (Ps. 25:4) will humble you and your people (2 Cor. 12:21), and make you sorry in a godly manner, that your sorrow produces repentance to salvation, that you might suffer no loss (2 Cor. 7:9-10). Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in His holy mountain. (Ps. 48:1)

In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), the rod out of the stem of Jesse, the Branch that grew out of his roots (Is. 11:1), may the God of mercy (Ps. 59:17), convict (John 16:18) and convert you and yours and all of your descendants, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that God may send **Jesus Christ** (Acts 3:19-20), the Holy Spirit (Luke 11:13), the Helper (John 14:16) and Comforter (Acts 9:31), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) to you and your house. In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and all of your family and all of your descendants may be baptized with water unto repentance (Matt. 3:11) to life (Acts 11:18), for the remission of sins (Mark 1:4). And that you and yours be baptized with the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:5) and fire (Matt. 3:11) through the grace of God your Father and **Jesus Christ** your Redeemer (Gal. 4:5). That through the baptism into death, you are buried with **Christ** and just as **Christ** was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so shall you walk in the newness of life (Rom. 6:4), knowing this, that your old man was crucified with **Christ**, that the body of sin might be done away with, that you

should no longer be a slave to sin (Rom. 6:5), but a slave to righteousness (Rom. 6:18). You who fear the Lord, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, and fear Him, all you offspring of Israel! (Ps. 22:23)

In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), who is faithful to Him who appointed Him (Heb. 3:3), may you and your people repent and make supplication to God saying "we, and our fathers before us (Neh. 9:2), have sinned and done wrong, we have committed wickedness" (1 Kin. 8:47). If you say you have no sin, you are deceiving yourselves. (1 John 1-8) For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. (Rom. 3:23) May you and your people confess your sins, for our Father in Heaven is faithful and just to forgive you your sins and to cleanse you from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and yours will turn, repent, hear instruction (Jer. 31:19), bear fruits worthy of repentance (Matt. 3:8), turn to God, and do works befitting repentance. (Acts 26:20) If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified. (1 Pet. 4:14) Let all those who seek the Lord our God rejoice and be glad in Him; let such as love His salvation say continually, "The Lord be magnified!" (Ps. 40:16)

In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), all things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that where you and your people have fallen, that you repent (Rev. 2:5) and return to your first love, Jesus Christ, and do the first works (Rev. 2:5). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will have an ear and will hear what the Spirit says, that you will overcome and the God of grace (1 Pet. 5:10) will give to you and yours to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God (Rev. 2:7). May, God your strength (Ps. 43:2), help you and your people be faithful until death that you will receive the crown of life, ...that you shall not be hurt by the second death (Rev. 2:10-11); that you and your people will hold fast to the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), and you will not deny His faith (Rev. 2:13), but overcome and receive the hidden manna to eat and a white stone with a new name (Rev. 2:17); that you and your people will hold fast what you have till the return of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ (Rev. 2:25), and let no one take your crown (Rev. 3:11). May you and your descendants keep Jesus' works until the end, that you will receive power over the nations (Rev. 2:26) and the morning star (Rev. 2:28). Let

not, you and your people defile your garments and you shall walk with Jesus in white, for you are worthy, and you shall overcome and be clothed in white garments ... Jesus will confess your name before His Father and before His angels (Rev. 3:4-5). Surely, you and your people will have a little strength, you will keep Jesus' word, and will not deny His name, that He will set before you an open door that no one can shut (Rev. 3:8). And your Redeemer (Gal. 4:5) will keep you from the hour of trial; you and your house will overcome and you will be a pillar in the temple of the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though He causes grief, yet He will show compassion to you and your family, according to the multitude of His mercies (Lam. 3:32) God grant that Jesus will write on you and your house the name of His God and the name of the city of His God, the New Jerusalem, and His new name. (Rev. 3:12) May the God of knowledge (1 Sam. 2:3) teach you and your house to buy from Jesus gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see (Rev. 3:18). Be zealous and repent. (Rev. 3:19) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will hear the voice of our Lord Jesus Christ and open the door so that He will come in and dine with you and your people, and He will be with you and your people, and He will grant you and your people to sit with him on His throne (Rev. 3:20-21). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we entreat Almighty God (Gen. 17:1) to give you and all of your people an ear to hear what the Spirit says, so that you will overcome, as Christ also overcame (Rev. 3:21). May you be counted among the Saints of the Most High, that the Ancient of Days will judge in your favor (Dan. 7:22). When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him (Matt. 25:31), we will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory (Matt. 24:30), then He will sit on the throne of His glory. (Matt. 25:31) Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men! (Luke 2:14) Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest! (Luke 19:38)

In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), He has by Himself purged your sins (Heb. 1:3), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we that the Holy Spirit would convict you and your house of sin and of righteousness and of judgment (John 16:8). May you and your people die to sin and live for righteousness, being healed by the stripes of Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 2:24), go on to perfection (Heb. 6:1) May you and yours be

cleansed by the blood of Jesus Christ His Son from all sin. (1 John 1:7) Let the God of the spirits of all flesh (Num. 16:22), cleanse you and your house from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in you and yours, (2 Cor. 7:1), making you and your people vessels for honor, sanctified and useful, prepared for every good work (2 Tim. 2:21). In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), let there be nothing covered that will not be revealed, and hidden that will not be known (Matt. 10:26). May you and yours not cover your sins, but confess and forsake them and receive the mercy of God and prosper. (Prov. 28:13) Let the God of all grace (1 Pet. 5:10) cleanse you and your family from any secret sins and teach you to be people who are quick to confess when you are wrong (Ps. 19:12). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and yours will acknowledge your sin to God, and not hide your iniquity, but confess your transgressions to the Lord so that you may be forgiven the iniquity of your sin. (Ps. 32:5) May God your helper (Ps. 54:4), help you and your house to pull down strongholds, cast down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, to bring every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, and to be ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled (2 Cor. 10:3) Let the Lord search you and your house and know your heart; try you, and know your anxieties, and see if there is any wicked way in you, and lead you in the way everlasting. (Ps. 139:23-24) Break the arm of the wicked and the evil man; seek out his wickedness until you find none, O Lord. (Ps. 11:15) May God cleanse you and your house from secret faults and keep back His servants also from presumptuous sin. Let sin not have dominion over you and your house. Then you and your house shall be blameless, and you shall be innocent of great transgression. (Ps. 19:12-14) If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. (1 Pet. 4:11) This in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God. (Phil1:9-11)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in Christ, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord Jesus Christ. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14), for God's thoughts towards you and your house are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11), we ask our Father in heaven, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), He who is able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him (Heb. 7:25),

believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14), petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38), and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9). For it is written "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12), and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it. For there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved, nor is there salvation in any other. (Acts 4:12) You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) For Yours, O Lord, is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
