SCORE SHEET PROCEDURES



Coaches and Managers:

How to properly fill out a score sheet:

- 1) Top of score sheet information (Home team responsibility)
 - Location
 - Town
 - Date
 - Division
 - Class
 - Game #
 - League
- 2) Write team names (Home team responsibility)
 - aa. Visitor
 - bb. Home
- 3) Place team labels on all 5 sheets White, Pink, Pink, Yellow, and Green on correct side (Home & Away team.
- 4) Attendance (Home & Away team)
 - cc. Indicate any suspension being served
 - dd. Cross out any player or team official not attending the game
- 5) Sign the score sheet (Home & Away team)

Referees & Timekeepers:

- 1) Indicate # of players and # of goalies example: 13 + 1
- 2) Indicate start time of game and end time of game
- 3) Indicate length of time of 3rd period
- 4) Indicate time left in 3rd period (important as it determines last 5 minutes of the game for suspensions)
- 5) Penalty minutes is a combined total of minors & major penalties
- 6) Close out penalty and score sections at end of game.
