a. Professional Development/Peer Observation Review - Maestra Jacobson reported her impressions of the peer review process thus far. After having been away for two years and then returning to BV, she sees real and positive change. The common goal for school-wide math improvement drove the peer observation project naturally towards the math curriculum. With funding from the BVPO, teachers were able to attend workshops and on-line trainings as well as conduct on-site peer observations. The following points were highlighted as a result of the experience thus far:

- * brought the staff together through learning
- * increased focus and purpose for staff
- * increased accountability
- * opened up channels of communication and development and staff feels ready to take process to the next level of self-evaluation through video taping teachers.
- * Reed Sheppard - hopes of inviting him monthly for further in-house professional training.
