

# DAY PASS GUIDELINES

**We love our spot on the Frio and the memories families are making here so much. We also know there is a lot of families that could use a break right now. So, we are excited to finally be able to find a way to accommodate non-RV families, as well as visitors of our overnight guests, with Day passes. We have hired a local third-party small business to help our small business make this happen. So, with our guests' help, this is how we can make this work:**

## **Day pass guidelines**

- Check in 10am no earlier.
- If arrived before 10am, park in our designated waiting lot, not on the road.
- RV/overnight guests are welcomed to have day pass guests at their sites, but day pass guests must leave the park by 8:00pm, no exceptions. Vehicles will be towed if not complied.
- 1-person (responsible party) checks in the group at the office and completes necessary registration paperwork.
- paper wristbands, car tag, and site will be issued; vehicle must stay parked at site.
- Wristbands must be worn on wrist or ankle while on property and must be easily visible or may be requested by EL Rods staff.
- Guests are welcomed to set up a shade canopy at their picnic site or take it down to the river. **DO NOT LEAVE ANY BROKEN CANOPIES, CHAIRS, OR TUBES**, please take it back with you to dispose of it; it overwhelms our limited resources, so we appreciate your help. **NO TENTS.**
- Must use EL Rods river access and property. Do not trespass on private property around EL Rods. Flags will be placed on property lines.
- Per game warden all guests can navigate up and down the riverbed (dry or not) but do not step onto private property riverbanks.
- Picnic table and BBQ pit will be set up at each site and not at the river; no ground fires are allowed at all.

No explicit music or profanity. We just ask everyone be respectful to each other and enjoy the Frio. There is plenty of room to spread out.

- Day pass guests are welcome to use park amenities but a courteous distance from overnight guest sites is expected.
- Keep our property beautiful and clean; put all trash in the blue barrels. Come and enjoy it and take care of it so the next family can enjoy their experience too. The Frio River is an amazing place to make memories.

 **DO NOT FORGET:** we are in a very rural area. Cell service is almost non-existent in most of our area because of where we sit in the canyon. Please plan for directions and information. **PURCHASE YOUR DAY PASS ONLINE PRIOR TO COMING OUT.** We will not sell more than 24 per day to contribute to social distancing guidelines. If you made the trip without purchasing ahead of time and we are sold out, we cannot let you in. We are a **PRIVATE PARK** and have a park limit. And again, cell service is not good out in all the Frio Canyon area.
