- ➤ This outstanding debt held with RUS is eligible to graduate under RUS's Letter of Conditions. Private refinancing instead of borrowing from a financial institution.

Motion made by Raymond Guzic 2nd Dennis Beck to authorize CMSA to work with Public Financial Management, Inc., as Financial Advisor, Boenning & Scattergood as Underwriter, and Lynch & Lynch, as Bond Counsel in conjunction with the issuance of General Obligation Bonds, Series 2013, via a negotiated sale for the purpose of refunding all or a portion of the Authority's outstanding 2006 RUS loan. Solicitor Report:

As Discussed:

- ➤ Correspondence from Robert P. Petyak concerning the John Shuniak connection to the Central Mainline Sewer Authority.
- Includes estimated cost for tap in, wants to borrow the authority's back hoe.
- > Everyone else on the CMSA system was solely responsible to pay for the cost of tap in.
- ➤ No communications has been received from Cassandra Borough as permit required and permission to use the old terra cotta line.
- > CMSA has provided Mr. Shuniak with a grinder pump.
- ➤ The amount of EDU's charged to the Cassandra Overlook Motel.
- ➤ The amount of time that has passed and this customer has not tapped into the CMSA sanitary sewer.

Motion made by Raymond Guzic, Jr., 2nd Dennis Beck to have Mr. Shuniak follow CMSA Rules and Regulations as every other customer who is served / and tapped into the sanitary sewer. Roll call, all in favor, Motion passed.

➤ Two delinquent customers who have not continued with the signed payment agreement for delinquent amounts, solicitor to continue with filing of liens against, 142 Club Road, Portage Township and 4464 Portage Street, Portage Township.

Plant Operators Report:

Plant operator monthly flow meter report was presented to the board.

As Discussed:

- George and Blueberry Dropped Manhole- expedient repair was completed, at minimal cost.
- ➤ Renewal for the Cumming Bridgeway Generator Maintenance Agreement. Plant operator has researched comparative maintenance agreements, Cumming was the lowest.

Motion made by Raymond Guzic, Jr, 2nd Dennis Beck to the Bridgeway Cumming Planned Generator Maintenance Agreement in the amount of \$699.46. Roll call, all in favor, Motion passed.

- ➤ The influent and effluent meters at the plant have been recalibrated as per DEP requirements.
- > During Hurricane Sandy the CMSA wastewater treatment plant incurred a violation for suspended solids, non-compliance form was submitted.
- > Several waste water treatment plants found themselves in violation due to high water infiltration.
- ➤ Hach flow meters brackets need to be ordered, Hach flow meter is working well
- Another electrical phase loss at the wastewater treatment plant, contactor was blown out on blower motor, modem on the ABJ panel is not working properly, blown fuse on the UV system.
- > CAMCO is repairing the blower motor.
- ➤ Electrical inspection needs to be completed for the plant; perhaps the generator is spiking an electrical surge when there is an electrical loss from the main power grid.
- **EAD's** group to review the electrical wiring schematics with an electrical engineer.

Motion made by Dennis Beck 2^{nd} Edward Myers to purchase a new modem for the ABJ control panel for the CMSA WWTP. Roll call, all in favor, Motion passed.
