Christ, who is all knowing, tells us that many people are going to be lost in eternity. In Matthew 7:13-14 He says, "Enter by the narrow gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that **leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it.**

Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads **to life, and there are few who find it**". According to the Bible the majority of people will be lost. We must take this warning seriously. The Lord says that only a few people will be saved.

How few can few be? In 1 Peter 3:20 (KJV) we read, "When once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was preparing, wherein few, that is eight souls were saved by water." The conservative estimate of the number of people on the face of the earth in the days of Noah is two hundred million (200,000,000) people.

But only eight (8) out of the estimated two hundred million (200,000,000) were saved. This is not very good odds. 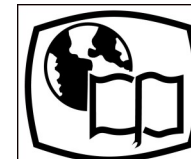
There is a nursery at the rear of the auditorium up the stairs for infant care.
