CROCKPOT TAILGATE SAUSAGE DIP

1 lb. ground spicy pork or turkey sausage
1 - 10 oz. can diced tomato and green chilies, drained
1 - 15 oz. can white corn, drained
1 - 8 oz. package cream cheese, cut into chunks
1 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese
Fritos or Tostitos Scoops

Cook sausage in a large skillet, stirring until meat crumbles and is no longer pink; drain well.

Mix sausage, diced tomato and green chilies, corn, cream cheese and cheddar cheese together and pour into crockpot. Heat on low until melted, then set on warm and serve with Fritos or Scoops. Go team!



FROZEN AVOCADO MARGARITA

2 cups crushed ice
6 fluid ounces tequila
4 fluid ounces lime juice
2 fluid ounces triple sec
1 avocado - peeled, pitted and diced
1 sprig fresh cilantro
coarse salt to taste

Place the ice, tequila, lime juice, triple sec, avocado, and cilantro into a blender, and blend until smooth. Pour into salt-rimmed margarita glasses to serve. Cheers!
