The Visitor



When you grow up in a farming community not all learning occurs on your farm, nor is the teacher always your Dad. One learning experience for me was when I was visited my cousin at his farm. I was the younger one and Doug is a

great guy, he let me tag along and would entertain me while our parents visited or when I needed watched when my parent were gone. Anyway, I was down at Doug's place and he had been told to go feed the cattle down in the pen. He took off and led the way with me chugging along behind him. We arrived at the pen and as he hopped the fence he yelled back, "Watch out for the electric wire, if you hit it with your leg you will get a shock." Well you see I was younger and despite having the name Schurle I do not possess the superior athletic ability of most with the name Schurle, so jumping this electric fence was not an option for me. So carefully following his directions I walked up to the wire, grabbed it with my hand, and pushed it down so my leg would not hit it when I crossed over. When the first zap hit me, I froze, there I was straddling the fence with my hand glued to the wire holding it down. It was only when the second zap bit me that I knew I had to let go of the wire...so I did. Now the third burst hit me and I will never forget that feeling as I jumped ten feet in the air. I don't think Doug saw any of the prior activity but he did see me land on the ground curled up in a little ball. Thinking I had caught my foot on the fence (no the third shock was not to my foot!) he had no compassion of me and yelled at me to get up so we could get the job done. Too ashamed to say what had just happened I did my best to not let on the pain I was in as we finished the task at hand. Despite thinking I had understood his advice, I could not have misunderstood it any worse.

Jesus gave advice to his disciples and despite him being quite clear, the disciple couldn't have misunderstood it any worse. Luke 18: 31-34 says - Then He (Jesus) took the twelve aside and said to them, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things which are written through the prophets about the Son of Man will be accomplished. "For He will be handed over to the Gentiles, and will be mocked and mistreated and spit upon, and after they have scourged Him, they will kill Him; and the third day He will rise again." But the disciples understood none of these things, and the meaning of this statement was hidden from them, and they did not comprehend the things that were said.

Seems really clear to me what Jesus was trying to say, doesn't it to you? Yet a message as simple as don't touch the fence as completely missed. Because of their misunderstanding they were completely unprepared for Jesus' arrest, torture and death. They scattered, ran away and hid! What a complete and epic failure. So after messing up this bad, what should they do? They did the only thing they could do and followed my cousin's advice, they got back up...dusted themselves off...and got to work. Accept God's grace and get busy. There is not one of us who hasn't made a mistake in following Christ. Don't quit, get up, confess, and then with God's grace, try again.

As you try again this week may God bless you all...real good!
