We Are RC 7!! We Are UNION for Life!



As a NYSUT retiree from a school district in Cayuga and Onondaga Counties, you became a part of Retiree Council 7 of NYSUT. Through this group, you can stay informed and active as a union member. All NYSUT retirees will remain a member of NYSUT for life and will receive communication from NYSUT at their addresses (US and email) of record. We work together to ensure our benefits are protected in retirement.

Active membership in Retiree Council 7 is open to every NYSUT retiree of any NYSUT represented group in Election District 7 - units in Cayuga and Onondaga counties. Active RC 7 members are those who have paid RC 7's participation fee of \$10 per year and, if required by the local, payment of local retiree fees.

Some locals in RC 7 have Chapters established for their retirees. Some locals keep an updated list of their retirees as part of their local membership. This is sometimes confusing. (See related story on page 2.)

If you retired from Jordan-Elbridge, Liverpool, North Syracuse, Port Byron, or Syracuse City, your fees are collected by your local (or chapter) and includes the voluntary RC 7 participation fee that is then sent to RC 7. The fees collected in these cases are determined by the local. You should use the local's address when sending in your check.

If you retired from Auburn, Cato-Meridian, Skaneateles, Southern Cayuga, Union Springs, or Weedsport, your fees are collected by CORN (Cayuga-Onondaga Retirees of NYSUT) and forwarded to RC 7. Send your check to CORN

From the President's Desk...

This issue's column is from Lilli Rastegar, one of five RC 7 Directors. Lilli is a Syracuse Teachers Association retiree and currently serves as the transurer of STARS, the STA Chapter of Retirees.

Hmmm....join which group? Where do I pay dues? What does the acronym stand for? What is a NYSUT retiree to do?

NYSUT has 46 Retiree Councils in New York State. As a member of a Local Union in Election District (ED) 7, once we retire, we move onto Retiree Council (RC) 7. In Central New York, RC 7 encompasses the counties of Cayuga, Onondaga, and RC 8 encompasses the counties of Oswego, Oneida, and Madison. As a retiree from a school district in one of these counties you belong to NYSUT RC 7 or NYSUT RC 8. The Central New York (CNY) NYSUT Regional Offices are in Syracuse for RC 7 and in New Hartford for RC 8 – both under the direction of Chris Colabello. Loretta Donlon is the current president of RC 7 and Jan Corn is the president of RC 8. Our Retiree Services Consultant (RSC) for RC 7 & 8 is Anne Marie Voutsinas. The two RCs have many events together since we are all located in Central NY.

As a NYSUT retiree from RC 7, you are a NYSUT member for life and a member of the American Federation of Teachers (AFT). To remain active and support our RC, you should do one of the following:

- Join your Retiree Chapter if your local has one. Your Chapter dues and your RC fee is included when you join.
- Send your Participation Fee to your local (see list on page one).
- Send in your \$10 Participation Fee to RC 7 directly.

RENY (Retired Educators of New York) was formerly known as NYSRTA (New York State Retired Teachers Association). There are chapters throughout the state. This organization is NOT affiliated with NYSUT. Paying dues to RENY does not cover membership in RC 7 or in any other local NYSUT retiree chapter.

EDs are election districts that comprise the governance structure for NYSUT. RC 7 & 8, and many other RCs from across the state, are part of ED 51. Loretta Donlon is the Director elected to represent us on the NYSUT Board of Directors. She is our voice, along with two elected delegates from our RC, who speak for us at all NYSUT governance events – such as the Representative Assembly (RA), and other delegate meetings.

As retiree members, we continue our life long union involvement for "economic, political and social advantages". (NYSUT Retiree Membership Handbook, 2018) Hope this little bit of information helps you navigate the alphabet of our UNION...
