## ABC BUILD YOUR FUTURE FIELD TRIP



### ATTENTION SENIOR PARENTS:



The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) can be filled out online at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) beginning October 1st. You do not need to wait until you have completed your current year's taxes which has been the protocol in the past. ALL SENIORS are encouraged to fill it out even if they are unsure about attending college at this moment or unsure about which school they will attend. You will need information from your and your student's **2015 tax return**. The sooner your senior's application is in the system, the better because grant money, money that does not need to be paid back, is distributed, by need, on a first come, first served basis. (\*\*PLEASE NOTE YOU SHOULD ONLY USE THE [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) WEBSITE AS A WAY TO FILL OUT THE FAFSA. There are similar websites that indicate they will help you fill out the FAFSA for a fee. You should NEVER PAY to fill out the FAFSA, it is a FREE application.)

Also, please mark your calendars for December 1st because a representative from the Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance (LOSFA) will be at Maurepas High School throughout the day to discuss all things related to financial aid, including assistance filling out the FAFSA, information on student loans and grants, as well as, information regarding TOPS.
