Florence DeCook, age 92 of Bay Port, passed away Friday, February 28 at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon.

She was born in Detroit on May 5, 1904, the daughter of the late Andrew and Elizabeth (Hamlyn) Hug. On June 22, 1922 she was united in marriage to Edward C. DeCook in Detroit. He preceded her in death on June 19, 1985.

Mrs. DeCook was a church organist at St. Bernard Catholic Church in Detroit and was a music teacher for piano and organ prior to moving to the area.

She was a member of St. Francis Borgia Catholic Church in Pigeon.

Her survivors include several nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by two sons, Edward C., Jr. and William Jon; three brothers, Charles, Henry, and Albert; and a sister, Mary Burkart.
