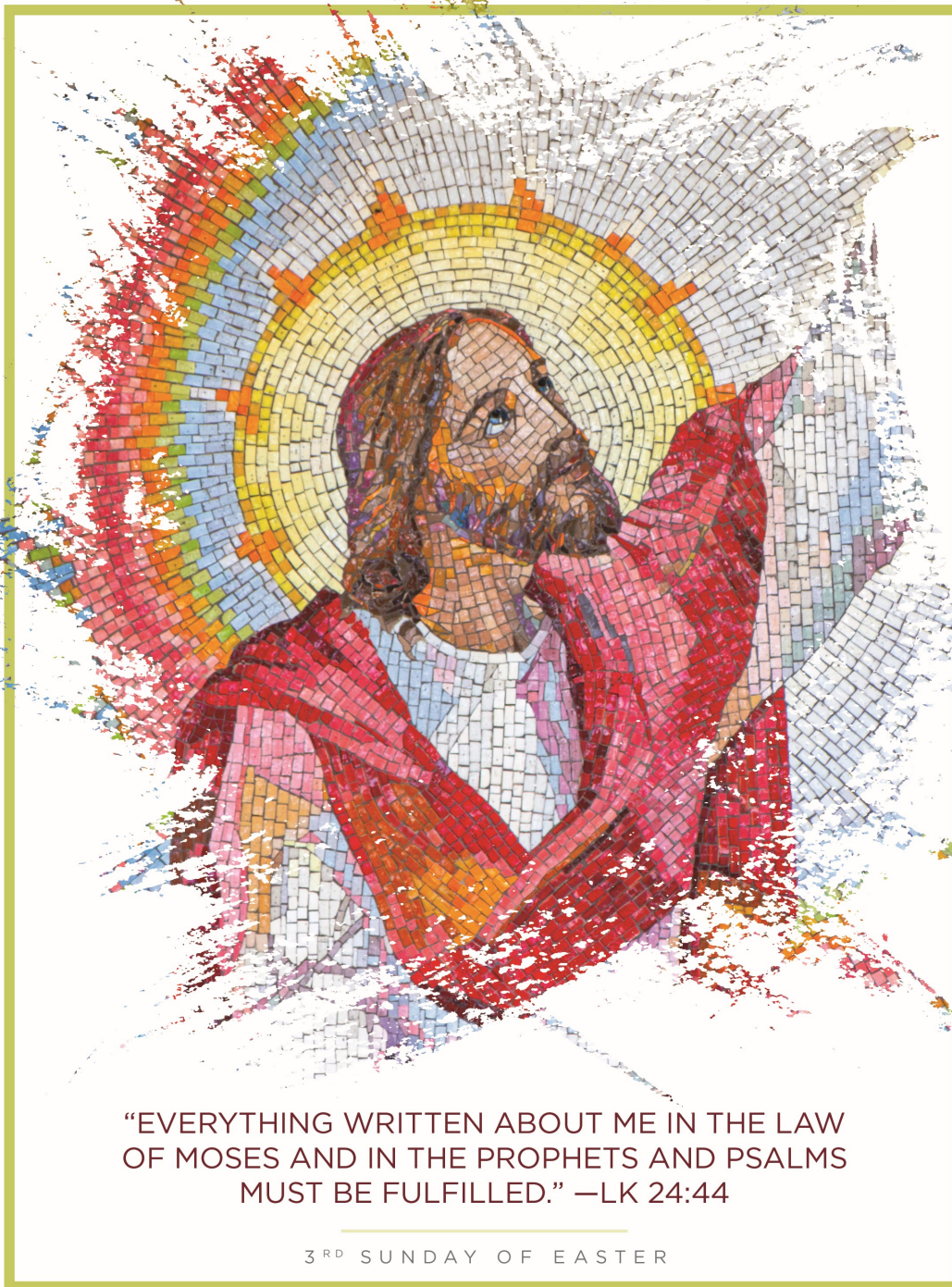


St. Pius Tenth CATHOLIC CHURCH

Relic of Saint Pius Tenth!

The dedication Mass on April 25th will include the deposit of a new relic of St. Pius Tenth under the new altar. There was no relic in the old altar or under it. This relic is a first class relic, which means it is an earthly mortal remains of a saint. These remains could be any part of the body including bone, flesh (either skin or organs), & even hair.

The relic request was initiated months ago by Bishop Medley to Rome. The Vatican office issued the relic (unknown what part of his body) & an authentic certificate in Latin. The original certificate will be displayed in the priest vestry. The relic will be sealed over after the dedication Mass.
