## *Water Department Updates/Facebook Page*

The fire hydrants have all been flushed for 2021 and residents can resume normal water use. The May 2021 Water Quality Report is attached for your information as required by IDEM. As we are entering into a Water Rehabilitation Project, there will be a lot of information we will be passing onto our residents. The best way to stay informed is through our Facebook page, Town of Cromwell. Please like and follow so you remain in the loop on the Water updates & other Town information. You may also want to sign up for our REACH alert system if you have not already. Contact the Town Hall for ways to join this emergency alert system.

**Trash Pick-Up:** In the event of a holiday, please prepare to have your trash/garbage picked up on the regular Tuesday morning schedule. Stuckman Sanitation attempts to keep us on schedule regardless of holidays but sometimes pushes us to the Wednesday morning based upon their schedule. Just be prepared it could be either day. Also remember, we allow up to 3 garbage cans to be picked up weekly. The cans must have lids and all trash must fit inside the cans. If you have further questions/concerns about what is being picked up, please reach out to Stuckman Sanitation directly.

## *Fireworks, Noise, & Animal Ordinance Enforcement*

**Fireworks:** You can be penalized from \$25-\$250 for letting off fireworks any time but the following:

- 1) 6/29, 6/30, 7/1, 7/2, 7/3, 7/5, 7/6, 7/7, 7/8, & 7/9 between the hours of 5:00pm-2 hours after sunset.
- 2) On July 4<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 10:00am and midnight.
- 3) Between the hours of 10:00 am on 12/31 and 1:00am on 1/1.

**Any other time is prohibited.** If we witness this violation or obtain proof of fireworks outside of this time, you can be fined as outlined above. Please be a good neighbor and be considerate of others.

**Noise:** No one is authorized to produce noise that unreasonably disturbs the peace and quiet of persons within the same vicinity. Those violating the noise ordinance and disturbing others may be fined \$50-500 for violations after a warning is issued.

**Chickens/Other Animals:** All animals are to be confined and are not to run at large. Animals found running at large may be fined \$25 for 1<sup>st</sup> violation, \$50 for 2<sup>nd</sup> violation, & \$100 for all other violations. Goats, Sheep, Pigs, Horses, Mules, Ponies, Cattle, Rabbits, Chickens, Ducks, Geese, Turkeys, Guineas, or other Farm/Fowl are only permitted so long as they are at least 200 ft from any other residence.
