2520... IN TIME (Past, Present, and Future)

PAST - THE 2520-YEAR PERIODS

In Ezekiel 4 God instructed Ezekiel to lie on his left side 390 days and his right side 40 days, for a total of 430 days. This seemingly strange object lesson had a prophetic dimension to it as well.

The 430 days represented Israel's and Judah's 430 combined years of rebellion. Their captivity in Babylon lasted 70 years, but there still remained 360 years of punishment. As the Bible confirms, Israel never repented and only a small minority returned under Ezra after the captivity. God anticipated this rebellion from what we are told in Leviticus 26. In that chapter, God warned Israel, if they didn't repent and return after the captivity, His seven-fold wrath would fall upon them. 360 years x 7 = 2520 remaining years of judgment. 2520 years x 360 days = 907,200 days.

1948 AD — Israel regains her sovereignty.

Israel lost her sovereignty in 605 BC. Subtracting the 70-year captivity, a perfect **2520**-year period (360×7) finds its fulfillment in 1948 when she regained her independence.

Using 586 BC as the beginning point of another measuring line, when Jerusalem is destroyed, one more 2520-year period (again subtracting 70 years for the desolations of Jerusalem) finds its fulfillment in 1967 when Israel recaptures Jerusalem. The day was June 7, 1967.

The eternal covenant of God with His *people* Israel cannot be separated from the *land* of Israel (Psalm 105:7-11) and its ultimate fulfillment is in accordance with His precise timing.



PRESENT - THE 2520-WEEK PERIOD

"There are forty-nine (7 x7) 360-day, prophetic years from the day Israel captured the Temple Mount on June 7, 1967 to Yom Kippur, September 23, 2015."

What are the mathematical odds that the same day on which Israel recaptured Jerusalem, a biblical cycle also began (7 x 7, 49-year, 360-day or 2520 weeks) which culminates on Yom Kippur, The Day of Atonement, and even more incredibly, The Day of Jubilee, a day that only occurs once every 50 years?

Forty-nine (7 x 7) 360-day periods have biblical significance as in Daniel chapters 5 and 9. This period could also be more precisely delineated as a **2520**-week period. This **2520**-week period began immediately after the 2nd **2520**-year period ended on June 7, 1967 and ends this September 23, 2015.

FUTURE - THE 2520-DAY PERIOD

The Bible has more to say about one particular future sevenyear period than it does about any other period of human history. This period of time is known as the 70th Week of Daniel, and the second half of this seven-year period the Bible calls The Great Tribulation, a period of 1260 days or 42 months, and "a time, times, and half a time." The whole period of seven years could also be more precisely counted as a 2520-day period.

If 2520 is God's fingerprint, His fingerprint is becoming more detailed as time marches on. The count began with the 2520-year periods, and continues with the 2520-week period and ultimately narrows to the 2520-day period.

Could the last period of seven years, or **2520** days, of human history before Messiah's Kingdom comes to earth, be close upon us?

Please understand that no prediction of any kind is made here. What is written is intended to bring to light a pattern evident in both God's Word and His World. This does not address the Church or the Rapture. The Church is a sign-less entity, as the Rapture is a sign-less event. God's time clock has always been the nation of Israel. His pattern has been to give Israel a sign and a warning before He continues His plan with them, both in geography (earth-measure) and in history. The apostle Paul said, "Jews require a sign" and God is gracious enough to give them one.


2520 is God's most precise unit of measure throughout His creation, both in time and in space.

TWENTY TWENTY DAYS WEEKS YEARS

"The handwriting is on the wall"



The phrase, "The handwriting is on the wall" is a well-known idiom for predicting the end of an era and judgment to follow. Its origin is from one of the most significant prophecies of the Bible.

The story is found in Daniel chapter 5 when a supernatural hand mysteriously appeared and wrote a puzzling message on the wall, "MENE, MENE, TEKEL, UPHARSIN," warning King Belshazzar of Babylon that his kingdom was finished. Each word represented a numerical value and was based upon the most precise unit of measure in the ancient Mideast, which together totaled 2520.

Literally, his number was up. It had been 2520 weeks to the day since his grandfather, King Nebuchadnezzar, had destroyed Jerusalem and the Temple. According to God's calendar, the Babylonian Kingdom was coming to an end that very night.

MENE comes from the word 'mina' and is equal to 50 shekels, so MENE, MENE is 100 shekels. TEKEL is another word for shekel, and therefore equals 1 shekel. UPHARSIN comes from the word 'to divide' and is half a MENE, or 25 shekels, which brings the total to 126 shekels. Ezekiel 45:12 tells us that each shekel is worth 20 gerahs, so the most precise units of measure for each of these 3 different words combine to equal 2520 gerahs.

God's own finger wrote **2520** on the wall that night, and we will see this same 'fingerprint' throughout His Word, and His Creation, both in time and space.

2520... IN HIS WORD

At the dedication of the original **altar** in Numbers 7, a total of **2520** shekels of gold and silver were given as an offering and 252 animals were sacrificed to the LORD. In 2014, the **altar** was rebuilt, and was dedicated on Hanukkah. It is now ready to be used at a moment's notice on the Temple Mount.

The **Ark of the Covenant** (described in Exodus **25:20**) was carried around the walls of Jericho seven times on the 7th day, demonstrating evidence of the divine standard. Seven 360 degree circles = **2520**.

As far as numbers in the Bible that signify actual objects, **2520** is the most temple-oriented. This is because, according to Daniel 9:27, the seven-year covenant (**2520** days) is based on the reinstitution of ritual sacrifice on the Temple Mount in Jerusalem, and **1260** days marks its interruption.

"Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week, but in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering."

Most conservative Bible students believe the exact time of fulfillment of Daniel's first 69 Weeks can be clearly deduced from Scripture (Luke 19:41-44). Is it possible the timing of the 70th Week is also indicated in Scripture?

This is Biblical Numerics, not Numerology...

The book of Revelation tells us, "Let him who has understanding <u>calculate</u> the <u>number</u>."

Daniel 8:13 mentions "a certain one" who gives one of the most time-specific prophecies in the entire Bible. The Hebrew word translated "a certain one" is a single word in the original and is the proper name Palmoni, which would be better translated, 'the Wonderful Numberer,' as it is in Young's Literal Translation.

The Bible uses the word 'wonderful' only when describing God or His works (Isaiah 9:6; Daniel 12:6). The 'Wonderful Numberer' of Daniel 8 is also the same one who wrote with His finger, "MENE, MENE, TEKEL, UPHARSIN" in Daniel 5 and is none other than the Lord Himself.

This is why it can be said that **2520** is the literal fingerprint of God, 'the Wonderful Numberer,' our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.

CHRONOLOGICAL PERFECTION

Why is 2520 so special to God?

2520 is found by multiplying the two most important numbers of Creation. The number of days in a week is 7, and the number of degrees in the circle of the earth is 360. One of God's names in the Bible is Eli-Shaba, meaning, God of the oath. Shaba literally means 'seven.' The strongest oath in the Bible was 'to seven oneself.' In Genesis 15 God established His covenant with Abram, and then in Exodus 6:4-8 He expands upon the covenant with Moses and the children of Israel; which contained His seven "I wills."

The Bible speaks of four numbers that demonstrate perfection: Three – speaks of divine perfection; Seven – speaks of spiritual perfection; Ten – speaks of ordinal perfection; and Twelve – speaks of governmental perfection. 2520 is the product of all four multiplied together, 3 x 7 x 10 x 12 = 2520. E. W. Bullinger called 2520 "Chronological Perfection." The smallest number that can be evenly divided by all the numbers 1-10 is 2520. Although the number 360 brings to mind completion, it cannot be evenly divided by all numbers 1-10 because it is not divisible by 7.

Prophecy has often followed previous patterns, and there are *types* in prophecy or those that have *dual fulfillment*. Note the parallel dates below that are separated by the same duration of years.

2520... IN SPACE

2520 not only solves Daniel's time-based prophecies, it's also a number of the proportion of creation.

A solar day is measured by one 360-degree revolution of the Earth, therefore a seven day week = 2520 degrees.

The earth's diameter is 7916.813 statute miles and is determined by multiplying $360 \times 7 = 2520$, and $2520 \times pi = 7916.813$

The moon's diameter is 2160 statute miles and is determined by subtracting the number of degrees in a circle, 360, from 2520.

The distance of the moon at its apogee from the earth is 252,088 statute miles.
