

Rick was able to make it to the show; despite needing to take it easy, he still ran the music, made announcements and handled the outcry auction.

Chef Pam and her crew grilled up tasty hamburgers, cheeseburgers, hot dogs, chicken and Brunswick stew. Pony veteran Leilani manned the beer tent with her usual flair.

The Pink Pony vendors provided some outstanding items for the auction, which raised \$990. Dennis Williams brought some "vintage" Pink Pony show tshirts to sell, with the proceeds benefiting the charity. Dennis also provided the Costume Contest prize money.

We gave out car awards for Best Classic, Best Modern, Top 15, Charity Pick ("Breast of Show"), Coolest Cruiser, and Pony Pick.
