School's out - time to be on the lookout for children

With more children on the roads and sidewalks now that schools are closing for the summer, there's a greater risk of motor vehicle accidents involving children. Aerie members should be more alert than ever for children playing on streets, in parking lots, and even in their own driveways.

Here are some tips:

- 1. If there's a ball rolling in the street, there's likely to be a child following. Slow down and be prepared to stop quickly.
- 2. Pay attention to the lone child walking along the street. Drivers are more likely to overlook a single youngster than several together.
- 3. Be aware of children on roller skates, skateboards, or roller blades who often roll onto streets from alleys or driveways.
- 4. Look out for bicyclists — especially young or new riders. Give them plenty of room.

Remember that children cannot judge speed or distance of vehicles moving toward them. They move quickly and can run into the street without warning. They don't know safety rules and expect adults to watch out for them. Look out for motorcycles.

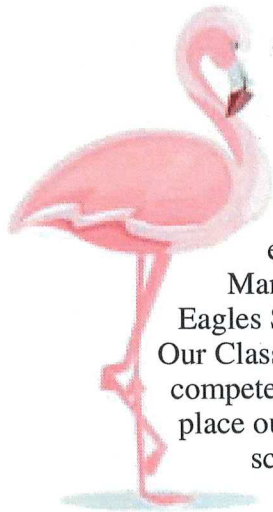


2019 - 2020 Aerie President Eric Kelm and Auxiliary Madam President Robin Sheffer at Installation.

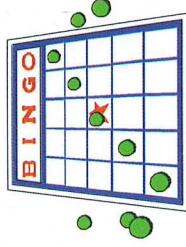

Once again we will be able to hold our annual Car Show at the Puyallup Eagles at our present location.

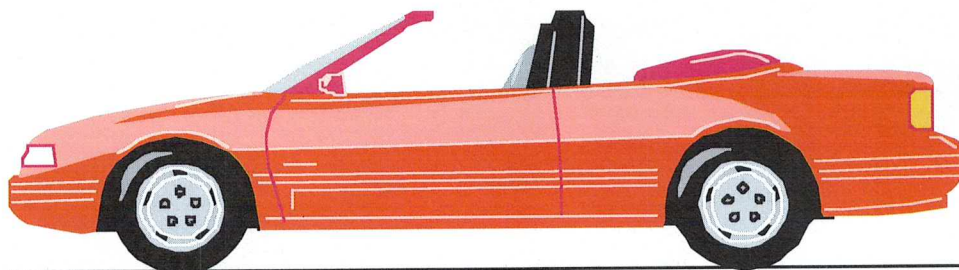
This will be the last one for sure. We are excited to at least be able to hold one more show.
