Facilities –

Show Arenas: 100' x 250' fenced sand outdoor, 80' x 150' indoor (dressage only), 3 acre fenced grass field

Mounted Warm-Up: Show arena not in use or grass by trailer parking. No lunging in arenas during show.

Lungeing: 60' diameter round pen with sand footing, or open grass by trailer parking

Trailer parking: Grass

Please leave dogs at home.

General CT Entry Guidelines

Horse and rider combinations may compete in no more than 2 consecutive divisions.

See Show Dates & Schedules on previous page for class start times. Jumping groups shown on the right.

Natural obstacles in the Summer Lovin' show may include, but are not limited to: logs, coops, brush boxes, roll tops, barrels, etc.

Ground Rails

Walk/Trot only. Judged on equitation and control. May be on or off lead (off lead encouraged)

Crossrail Jumpers

Fences set as crossrails - Optimum Time (250 mpm) - No oxers/triple bars/combinations

Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter any into any class showing 2'3" or higher. Riders will be encouraged to complete the entire course. Eliminations will be based on horse/rider safety, not refusals.

Puddle Jumpers

Fences set at 2' - Optimum Time (275 mpm) - No wide oxers/triple bars/combinations

Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter any into any class showing 2'6" or higher. Riders will be encouraged to complete the entire course. Eliminations will be based on horse/rider safety, not refusals.

Debut Jumpers

Fences set at 2'3" - Table II.2.b - No wide oxers/triple bars/combinations

Low Schooling Jumpers

Fences set at 2'6" - Table II.2.b - No wide oxers/triple bars, combinations are allowed

Intermediate Jumpers

Fences set at 2'9" - Table II.2.b - Triple bars and combinations are allowed

Medium Schooling Jumpers

Fences set 3' - 3'3" - Table II.2.b - Triple bars and combinations are allowed

High Schooling Jumpers

Fences set 3'3" - 3'6" - Table II.2.b - Triple bars and combinations are allowed

Gambler's Choice

Fences set 2'6" - 3'3"

Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into Gambler's Choice - Rookies.

Single fences (verticals and oxers) will be set up so they can be jumped from either direction and each fence will be assigned a point value. Horse/rider combinations will have 90 seconds from the start whistle to jump as many jumps as they can in any order. No fence may be jumped more than twice. No fence will count toward the point total if there is a refusal, a rail is knocked down, or the fence is jumped after it has been altered by a previous attempt (rail down, etc.). After the 90 seconds has passed the judge will blow the whistle and the competitor must cross the start/finish line. They may then take one attempt at the Joker fence worth 200 points. Clearing the fence will add 200 points, a rail down or refusal will reduce their score by 200 points.
