## REACT Alert Exercise 2017 - 17-18 November

ALERTEX 2017 was a REACT International alerting exercise for all member teams in the United States, Puerto Rico, Canada, Trinidad and Tobago, the Philippines, and Thailand. The exercise was conducted by the REACT International Training Committee.

## **OBJECTIVE:**

1. To test REACT's ability to alert Teams by e-mail to a major disaster using messages in an American Radio Relay League/International Amateur Radio Union/Radio Relay International radiogram format.
2. To gather readiness data from individual Teams in a global disaster scenario using a preformatted ICS/IMS Form 213 format message.
3. To make an initial baseline assessment of REACT's capability to react to a major disaster with global impacts.

On November 17th email was sent as follows:

**On November 18th second email was sent as follows:**

*"This is an ARRL/IARU/RRI format radiogram.*

We had a total of 17 of 25 respond to the email. The breakdown of availability (one member was available for both) was as follows:

12 hours locally – 12 members

72 hours regionally – 2 members

Not Available - 4 members

As Secretary I responded with the availability on the ICS213C provided. We then received an email thanking us for our participation and that we were relieved from the exercise.
