Habitat for Humanity International’s (HFHI) policy on income limits states that the household income of applicants should fall between 30% and 60% of the median income for the county in which the house will be located. The policy also states families with incomes greater than 60% of the median income can still be considered as long as their income does not exceed 80% of the median income. Further, the policy states Affiliates should take into account family size when looking at household income utilizing methodology developed by HUD.

The above income limits are current for FY 2016 and are subject to change in FY 2017.
