


A Day At The Park is an event to raise awareness and money for Fragile X.



Girls Night Out - Chicago - Research Study

Do you need a little respite in July, August or September?

Here's the perfect opportunity. A Fragile X Female Carrier Study is being conducted in Chicago and not only do they need female carriers but they need control subjects as well. A control subject is an individual who is not a carrier of fragile X.

Grab a friend, drive in on Tuesday and enjoy Chicago before participating in needed research! The study visits are **only** on Wednesdays.

If it's impossible for you to get away but you have a friend, who is not a fragile X carrier, and they would like to participate in research please share this information.

The goal of the study is to find out whether certain medical illnesses are more common in female Fragile X carriers compared to women who are not carriers. They will screen for neurologic problems (for example tremor or walking difficulties) and endocrine problems (like thyroid disease). They are also looking at what might be causing these symptoms by studying the fragile X gene and protein in blood and skin cells.

The study visit itself will begin at 8 a.m. and last approximately 5 hours including a few breaks. You would meet a neurologist, a neuropsychologist and an endocrinologist, along with filling out some questionnaires.


Between the Lines - Featured Book Perfect Game by Fred Bowen






What happens when a clinical drug trial terminates early? For me, Sally Nantais, it created devastation and shattered dreams. Like many, I soon discovered I was not alone. So we do what we do best, we band together and become the advocates our children and our community need us to be.

Arbaclofen (STX209) was in Phase III testing for fragile X syndrome and Phase II testing for autism. Both of these clinical trials had optional extensions if families found success with use of the drug.

On May 15, 2013 Seaside Therapeutics, Inc., the sponsor of Arbaclofen, sent a communication to the clinics involved in the administration of Arbaclofen stating the following: "We regret to inform you that Study 209FX303 [An Open-Label Extension Study to Evaluate the Safety, Tolerability, and Pharmacokinetics of STX209 (arbaclofen) in subjects with Fragile X Syndrome] is being terminated immediately. The closure of the study is due to resource limitations at Seaside Therapeutics, Inc., and is not related to any known safety issues in patients dosed with STX209."
